## Td POLIO (Td-IPV) Vaccine is No Longer Available

Tetanus, diphtheria and inactivated polio (Td-IPV) vaccine has been discontinued by the manufacturer.

- The vaccine was used for adult catch-up schedules, usually for travel purposes.
- Separate tetanus (Td) and inactivated polio (IPV) vaccines are available to replace the discontinued Td-IPV product.
- Tdap-IPV continues to be available.
- Current Td POLIO stock has an expiry date of January 31, 2019.

Orders for Td-IPV vaccine, sent after November 16 should be resubmitted using the attached updated order form.

- Tetanus (Td) is packaged in 5 single dose vials per box
- Inactivated polio (IPV) is packaged in single dose, prefilled syringe

## **Hepatitis Vaccine Shortages on Private Market**

Hepatitis A, B and combined vaccines continue to be unavailable on the private market. The situation is expected to improve in January 2019. Information on vaccine shortages can be found at <u>drugshortages.ca</u>.

For clients who meet high-risk criteria for publicly funded hepatitis A or B vaccines, please order directly from Toronto Public Health at toronto.ca/ordervaccines. Vaccines are in good supply for high risk individuals.
