## Rosehill Reservoir Rehabilitation: Work on Saturdays

Contract #: 17ECS-MI-03WA Start Date: Saturday November 3, 2018 End Date: Saturday December 22, 2018

\*Timeline is weather dependent and subject to change.

The City's contractor will be carrying out rehabilitation work on the Rosehill Reservoir on Saturdays (9 a.m. to 5 p.m) starting Saturday November 3 to Saturday December 22, 2018. Work on Saturdays will help to facilitate the Phase 1 construction schedule and will involve soil removal, removing existing waterproofing membrane and installing new waterproofing membrane.

Saturday construction activities include the following impacts (similar to those during the weekdays):

- **Soil removal**: small construction vehicles will remove soil from the reservoir roof and create a small stockpile within the Main Access Point at Avoca/Rosehill. Trucks will not idle on local roads.
- Existing Membrane Removal: a high-pressure power-washer system will produce continuous noise
- **New Membrane Installation**: a hot applied rubberized waterproofing system will produce smoke and odour. This is a standard procedure used to waterproof significant infrastructure.

## WHAT TO EXPECT DURING CONSTRUCTION

You may experience dust, noise and other inconveniences. The City will make efforts to reduce the impacts. We appreciate your patience.



Saturday Work Hours: 9 a.m. to 5 p.m.



**Soil Removal:** The existing soil on top of the reservoir will be removed and replaced. Trucks will access the site at the Main Access Point at Rosehill and Avoca Avenues. **Trucks will not idle on local roads.**
