Re: Sponsored Travel provided by the Confederation of Shenzhen Associations of Canada and the Foreign Affairs Office of Shenzhen Municipal People's Government for Your Trip to Shenzhen, China, November 16-20, 2016

Thank you for providing me with a Travel Declaration Form for the above-noted trip. I confirm that the travel related benefits you have disclosed are in compliance with section (f) of Article IV (Gifts and Benefits) of the *Code of Conduct for Members of Council* as travel was sponsored by an event organizer and a foreign government within a foreign country and you attended in your official capacity as the leader of a City Delegation to the 18th China Hi-Tech Fair.

I form this view based on my review of:

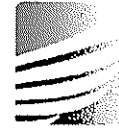

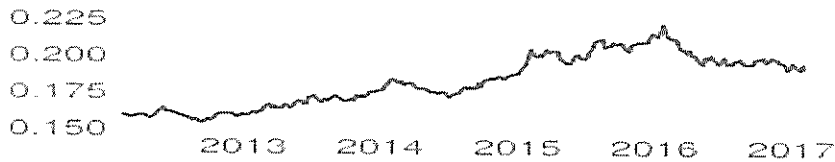

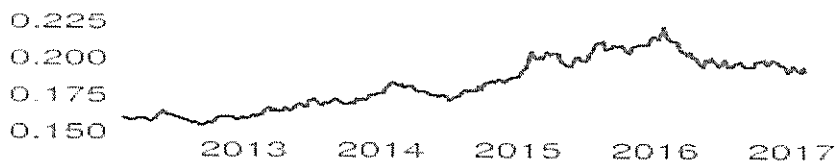
