

The City of Toronto is planning to repair a damaged parapet wall on the Steeles Avenue East Bridge over Little Rouge Creek. This work will ensure that the bridge meets today's standards and remains safe for vehicles and pedestrians into the future. The project is part of the Council-approved 2019 Capital Works Program.

Construction Notice

	Work Hours : Work will take place from 7:00 am to 7:00 pm., Monday to Friday, with work after hours and on weekends as required.
خ	Road and Sidewalk Access: In order to complete the work in a safe manner, there will be road and sidewalk restrictions within the construction work area. The north sidewalk along Steeles Avenue will be closed.
3	Traffic Management : Efforts have been made to manage traffic in the area for the safety of workers, road users and residents. Road users should expect delays and increased traffic on nearby main and side streets.
	One shared lane of traffic will be provided. Flag persons will control the direction / flow of traffic over the bridge during active construction hours.
	Regular lane use will be provided outside active work hours (in the evening and on weekends).
.	Restoration: The construction work area will be restored with sod and/or asphalt where required. Interlocking bricks, flagstone on a granular base, or other similar features that are removed during construction will be replaced.
Ė	Accessible Accommodation: Residents who require accommodation (level entry, longer notice, clear sidewalk path, etc) must contact the Project Manager to arrange for access during the construction period.
