Consultation Report

TO360 Wayfinding Strategy (Phase III) – Year One, Round One Workshops - November 2017



This is a summary of feedback received in six Local Stakeholder Mapping Workshops held in November, 2017. A draft summary of each workshop was shared with participants for review.

Background

Toronto 360 (TO360) is an effort to help people find their way by making streets, neighbourhoods, and the city more legible. Following the successful completion of a pilot project in the Financial District in 2015, the City began a five-year city-wide rollout in 2017. This rollout is focused on developing a map database that will support the future production of wayfinding maps. In Year One of the rollout, (the focus of this Consultation Summary), the TO360 team is developing the map database in an area bounded roughly by Lake Ontario, Royal York Road, St. Clair Avenue, and Warden Avenue.

In November 2017, the City of Toronto's Transportation Services Division (along with Steer Davies Gleave, T-Kartor, and Swerhun Facilitation, consultants to the City) delivered Round One of a two-round consultation program. Round One consisted of six Local Stakeholder Mapping Workshops within the Year One mapping area. These workshops focused on introducing local stakeholders to TO360 and seeking their input about district names, walking routes and barriers, commercial destinations, places of interest, and landmarks. The feedback from these workshops will support the development of a sign placement strategy, updates to the TO360 map database, and the production of draft wayfinding maps. Round Two will focus on presenting and seeking feedback on the draft wayfinding maps.

Local Stakeholder Mapping Workshop process

In each workshop, the City and Steer Davies Gleave delivered an overview presentation, responded to questions of clarification (see Appendix A), and worked with participants to document their feedback on: a broad, area-wide map; four detailed, focused-area maps, and; individual worksheets. Participants also shared feedback in writing or on the phone after the workshops. The maps shared included the following features to help structure the conversation:

- District names, such as Cabbagetown, Bloor West Village, Little Italy, Riverside, etc.
- **Commercial areas,** or streets with a continuous stretch of retail activity, such as College Street in Little Italy, Danforth Avenue in Greektown, etc.
- Places of interest, such as schools, libraries, shops, museums, parks, hospitals, etc.

The team asked participants about the accuracy of the maps, pedestrian routes and barriers, and landmarks. Specifically, the team was looking to learn:

- **District names**. Are there any district names that should be added, removed, changed, or double-checked?
- Walking routes and barriers. What are the broader area and more local pedestrian routes in the area? What are the barriers to pedestrian movement?
- **Commercial destinations.** Are there any commercial areas that should be added, removed, changed, or double-checked?
- **Places of interest.** Are there any places of interest that should be added, removed, changed, or double-checked?
- Landmarks. What are the city-wide or district-specific landmarks in this area? Which landmarks should be considered for 2D drawings on the wayfinding maps?
- Other. Do you have any other advice to share with the team at this time?

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Year One Round One Consultation Areas

How this consultation report is organized

This consultation report documents feedback shared in the Year One Round One workshops, with each Local Stakeholder Mapping Workshop summarized in its own section. Each summary section includes detailed comments participants shared on maps, in feedback forms, and over email. The feedback is organized under five categories:

- Feedback about district names
- Feedback about commercial areas
- Feedback about places of interest
- Feedback about landmarks
- Other feedback

For the feedback about **district names**, **commercial areas**, and **places of interest**, participants' feedback is organized in tables that identify:

- the name of the district, commercial area, or place of interest;
- whether participants suggested adding, removing, changing, or double-checking the district, commercial area, or place of interest;
- a description of the location of the district, commercial area, or place of interest (when applicable), and;
- any detailed advice or comments participants gave about the district, commercial area, or places of interest (if given).

Where participants were discussing a district name or place of interest that appeared on the maps, the name listed in the table corresponds to the name as it appeared on the maps. Where participants were unsure of the name of an area or place of interest, the name appears in "quotation marks."

For the feedback about landmarks, participants' feedback is organized in tables that identify:

- the name of the suggested landmark;
- whether participants considered the landmark a city-wide landmark, a district landmark, or had mixed opinions about whether it was of city-wide or district importance;
- whether participants suggested the landmark should be considered a candidate for a 2D drawing on wayfinding maps, and;
- any detailed comments or explanations participants shared about the comment.

For **other feedback**, participants' comments are summarized in text.





VV HCD submission document says: "St. Pius Church is a landmark on the Bloor West mmercial core. The building is distinct in its esence with a reference to the Modernist le, set apart from the commercial buildings either side and across the street."

1.5 — Other Feedback: Area 1

General feedback about wayfinding in Area 1

- Do not encourage people to visit High Park until there is a Management Plan in place for the park. Encouraging more visitors could hurt High Park's ecological integrity.
- Find a way for the signage to recognize the Teiagon history in Baby Point.
- There is an interesting walk along Clendenan from Bloor to Humberside Collegiate because it is built on a ravine. This walk could be identified on the maps.
- There is a cluster of churches near High Park Avenue and Annette that people might want to know about.
- There is a rare plant species in South Humber Park: the team should consider if or how to point this out. On one hand, it might be worth highlighting this area for people to appreciate it, but on the other, the area needs to be protected from damage resulting from too much attention.

Specific areas that could benefit from wayfinding

Participants shared suggestions on specific areas that they thought would benefit from wayfinding signage, including:

- The Corner of Queensway and Sunnyside: there is a TTC stop here and many schools nearby.
- At the corner of Bloor and Armadale, especially to help people find Swansea Town Hall.
- The pedestrian connection between Kingsmill Park to South Humber Park via Humber Valley Road, Riverwood Parkway, and Stephen Drive. These two parks are linked by the street network but it's not clear how you get between them.
- The connection between the west bank of the Humber and Old Mill subway station. This route is not well-marked and requires use of a long set of steep stairs (down the side of the Humber valley, beside the bridge that carries Bloor Street over the Humber).

Other comments about the maps

Participants shared some other comments and suggestions about the maps:

- Identify the entrances on St. Joseph's Health Centre, including: at Pearson Ave & Sunnyside, Marion & Sunnyside, and the main entrance on the north side of Queensway between Sunnyside and Glendale. Finally, they suggested identifying the emergency entrance midblock on Glendale.
- The land north and east of Grenadier Heights should be identified as private land.








Annotated Broader Area 2 Map








Annotated Focused Area 3 Map: Northwest



4.5 — Other Feedback: Area 4

General feedback about wayfinding in Area 4

- Consider calling "active areas" "active frontages" instead. Double check the Area 4 active frontages, because it seems many are missing from the map.
- All hotels on the map should have the word "hotel" on the label name to make them easy to identify.
- Consider differentiating between major and minor district (by using different font sizes or colours).
- Consider referencing Indigenous lands and place names.
- Consider asking people form the suburbs about landmarks for an outside point of view.
- Make sure the maps use international symbols and/or other languages to help those who cannot read English.
- Consider making the signs light up at night.
- Consider adding beacon technology to the totems so they can communicate with people's smartphones.

Suggested specific areas to recognize in Area 4

Some participants shared suggestions on specific areas that they thought should get special treatment on the Area 4 maps:

- **Parliament Square Park**. This park should have special heritage recognition.
- **Church-Wellesley Village**. Consider adding a rainbow symbol to this area.
- **Ryerson campus**. Consider removing the individual building names and identifying Ryerson University as a general, broad area.
- Harbourfront Centre. Show the same amount of detail for Harbourfront Centre as shown for the Distillery District.
- **Bennet Gates** at the south end of Philosopher's walk. This is an important decision point that would benefit from wayfinding signage.











Annotated Focused Area 4 Map: Northwest

 Consider extending the area of study to the Don Valley in area 5 and the west side of Area 6. Otherwise, the cut-off for these areas is artificial and does not follow natural area boundaries. The natural northern boundary of these areas is the Don Valley. The current cut-off misses relevant trail access points to the Don Valley and some small commercial areas (on Jones and Coxwell, south of O'Connor).

Participants identified a few areas that would be changing in the future on the maps:



6.5 — Other Feedback: Area 6

General feedback about wayfinding in Area 6

- The Area 6 boundary should extend one block east of Warden since that is an area that would benefit from mapping and signage.
- Consider extending the area of study to the west side of Area 6. Otherwise, the cut-off for this area is artificial and does not follow natural area boundaries. The natural northern boundary of these areas is the Don Valley.
- Consider finding a way to recognize some of the area's unique characteristics, including:
 - Neville Park: the terminus of the 501 streetcar route (the longest streetcar ride in the world)
 - The historic area around Gerrard and Main (East Toronto)
 - The location of the first ever Shoppers Drug Mart in the Shoppers World Danforth

Specific areas that could benefit from wayfinding

Participants shared suggestions on specific areas that they thought would benefit from wayfinding signage, including:

- The intersection of Danforth Road and Danforth Avenue
- The intersection of Danforth Avenue and Warden Avenue
- The West Scarborough Neighbourhood Centre is a destination that many people struggle to find.

Other comments about the maps

Participants shared some other comments and suggestions about the maps:

- Make sure The Beach is referred to as The Beach, not The Beaches.
- The East York District refers to a broader geography than most of the other district names; it may need to appear in a larger font to differentiate it.
- Check whether there is public access to St. John's Norway Cemetery for the public.
- Check and add the pedestrian route through Williamson Park Ravine and the Cassels Avenue Playground
- Make sure that private areas read as private, including:
 - \circ $\;$ The grey area north of The Quarry Café
 - \circ $\;$ The land on both sides of the rail corridor (parallel to the corridor).

Appendix A. Questions of Clarification

This section summarizes questions and responses shared across all six Local Stakeholder Mapping Workshops. Responses from the City and consultant team follow each question.

- Could you clarify the statement that 40% of people that live in the City are non-Torontonians? The number refers to the number of people that live in the city but were not born here. It is likely an even higher percentage than that.
- Are the maps intended to be static (i.e. non-digital)? Yes, the printed maps on the totems, TTC shelters, and other platforms will be static. However, the map asset that the City is developing as part of this work will be a digital database that the City could make available to third parties to develop digital wayfinding services (such as an app).
- Some areas are facing rapid change because of redevelopment should we be noting those on these maps? Yes, please point these areas out.
- How often will the City update the maps to ensure they are up to date? The map asset (database) will be updated on an on-going basis. The printed maps will be refreshed every 18 months to two years depending on how much the area is changing. The maps are also designed to minimize the amount of information changes frequently (such as shops, bars, and restaurants).
- Who will own the signs? The City's Transportation Services Division.
- Will the signs include links to digital assets? Won't people just use mapping apps? No, the plan is • not to include a link to the City's website. Based on a post-pilot survey, the team learned that the signs had an influence in reducing the number of trips people take, the time it takes them to travel, and their awareness of what is around them: benefits that digital mapping apps do not bring.
- Have you done research outside of Downtown? Yes, Phase 1 of TO360 focused on a city-wide analysis of wayfinding needs.
- Is the City aware of the "Digital Main Street" service that's being pitched to BIAs? Yes, the City has reached out to Digital Main Street to discuss potential connections between their service and TO360.
- Is there a plan for the TO360 mapping to go into the subway? Yes, the TTC is currently piloting a TO360 map at King Subway Station. The intent is for the TTC to adapt the TO360 specification system-wide.
- Will you consider expanding the approach taken with the PATH to other interior complexes (such as MacDonald Block)? There is currently no project planned with other complexes, but the City would be open to opportunities to work with them if they show interest.
- Does TO360 focus on people who live in Toronto or just visitors / tourists? The system is designed to meet the needs of both. Some information is devoted more to tourists (such as attractions and major destinations) and some is for locals (such as Bike Share stations).
- How have you thought about the fact that over 140 languages are spoken in Toronto? We know it's not possible to include 140 languages on the map, so we've included the English names to be consistent with the street signs and the naming people will encounter in the city. The system will also use international symbols for things like parking, washrooms, bus stops, and other places of interest so as to be legible to non-English speakers. Finally, the digital map asset could be used by apps or other services to provide wayfinding services to non-English speakers.

- What degree of customization is permitted on the wayfinding signs? Very little, because the maps to include their logo.
- How does the map orient to the viewer? Does it have a compass? The totem maps are oriented are oriented "north up." The maps do include a compass.
- Does the design of the sign consider mobility issues? Yes, it highlights areas where people of all be legible at a height that would be accessible to a person in a mobility device.
- Why are there two totems? The narrow one is designed to go on sidewalks to help people navigate, while the wider one is designed to at major decision points (such as outside Union Station).
- Do the signs include braille? The team tested braille as part of the pilot, and it was well-received, but the Canadian National Institute for the Blind recommended smartphones as a better way to provide wayfinding. The signs are not planned to include braille.
- Do the signs need to be in English and French? No. The City is only required to print signage in both official languages if it draws on federal funding.
- Will the City be placing the fingerpost signs on hydro poles? No.
- Are you going to share the information from this project with Parks for their wayfinding strategy? • The aspiration is make the data between Parks and Transportation Services consistent, however Parks will need to have separate discussions to focus on information specific to park users' needs
