F. G. Gardiner Expressway Rehabilitation Access Platform Installation Lake Shore Boulevard East between Cherry Street and Lower Jarvis Street

Contract #: 18ECS-TI-01GE Expected Start Date: February 19, 2019 Expected End Date: December 2019 *dates subject to change.

The City of Toronto will begin construction on the Gardiner Expressway between Jarvis Street to Cherry Street this summer as the first project of the Gardiner Expressway Strategic Rehabilitation Plan. In order to prepare for this work, crews will install access platforms on the underside of the Gardiner Expressway. In late-winter/early-spring 2019, there will be overnight intermittent lane restrictions on Lake Shore Boulevard East, from Cherry Street to Lower Jarvis Street as crews begin to install the access platforms.

This is the first project of the 10-year Gardiner Expressway Strategic Rehabilitation Plan (from the 427 to the DVP) which sets out the immediate and long-term rehabilitation needs of the expressway to ensure it remains in a safe and operable condition, now and in the future. Future notice will be provided before work on the Expressway starts.

WHAT TO EXPECT DURING CONSTRUCTION

• The community will experience dust, noise and traffic delays. Your patience is appreciated.

8	Traffic Management : Efforts have been made to manage traffic in the area for the safety of workers, road users and residents.	
	 During the rolling closures, one or two westbound lanes on Lake Shore Boulevard East between Cherry Street and Lower Jarvis Street will be closed for 15 minutes at a time, no more frequent than once every hour. 	
	 Vehicles will block one or two lanes during the rolling closures. 	
	 For the rolling closures from Tuesday, February 19 to Thursday, March 7, 2019, at least one westbound lane will remain open at all times. 	
	 On February 25 and 26 and March 4 and 5, there will be one full-lane closure from 10 p.m. to 5 a.m. instead of the rolling closures. 	
汴	Pedestrians: The work may require temporary sidewalk restrictions, however any necessary sidewalk closures will alternate in each direction to ensure pedestrian access is maintained during construction.	
	Work Hours: From Tuesday, February 19 to Thursday, March 7, 2019, the rolling lane closures will take place for 15 minutes every hour between 10 p.m. and 5 a.m.	
	After March 7, further lane closures will be required on Lake Shore Boulevard East between Cherry Street and Jarvis Street so crews can continue to install access platforms on the underside of the Gardiner Expressway and conduct other repairs. A series of lane closures is anticipated to continue until December and may take place during the day and/or overnight. The details, timing and impact of this work will be communicated in advance.	
	More information will be provided prior to work occurring.
