

Access during road reconstruction on Dundas Street West and Dunbloor Road

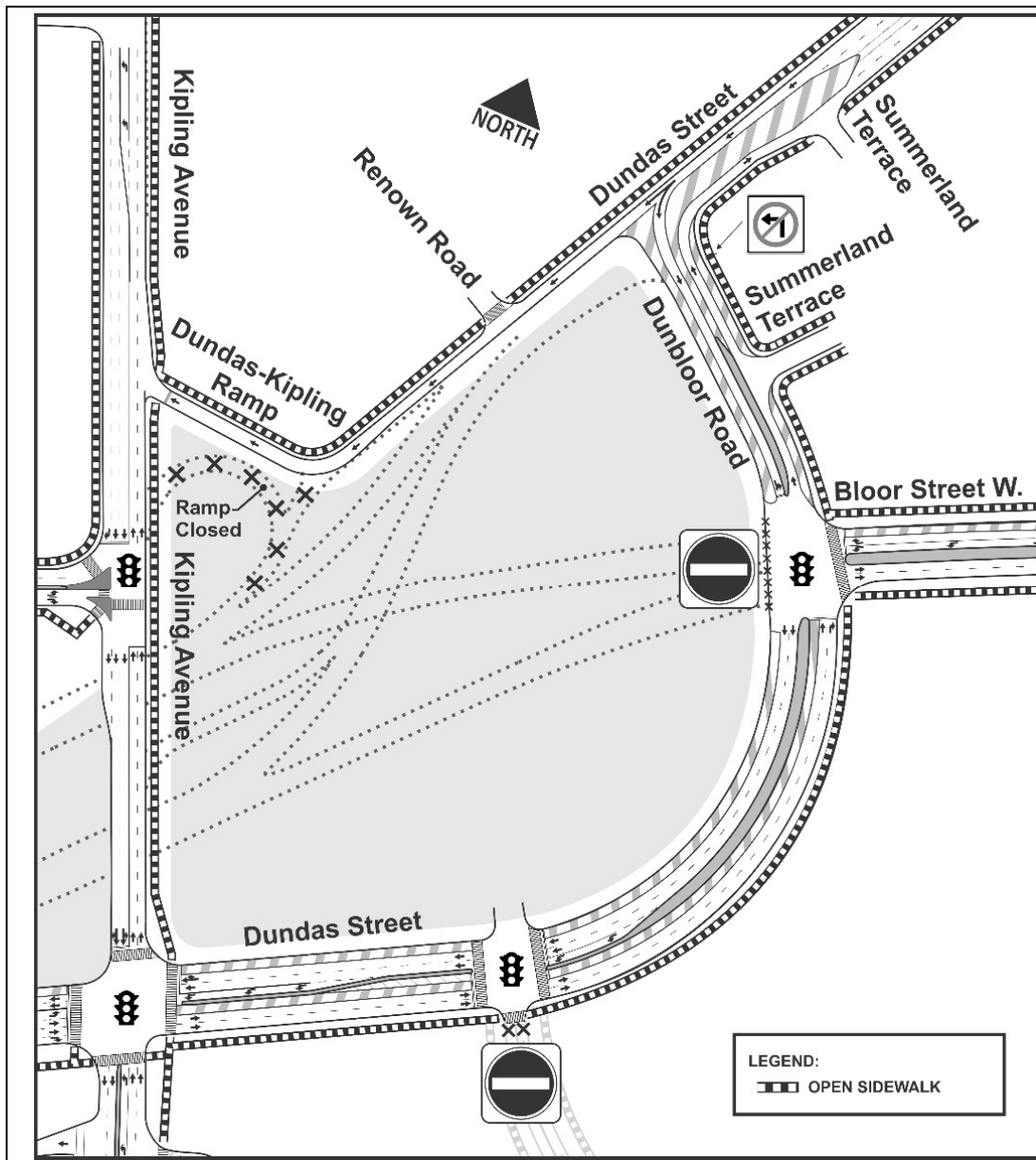
Contract: 16ECS-TI-01SP | Start Date: Sunday February 24, 2019 | Anticipated End Date: Summer 2019

The City's contractor is working to complete improvements to Dundas Street West and Dunbloor Road as part of the Six Points Interchange Reconfiguration. The contractor has finished much of the work along the north side of Dundas Street West, and construction continues at locations along Bloor Street West, Kipling Avenue, Dundas Street West, and Kipling access ramps. To manage traffic during construction, effective February 24, 2019:

- **Dunbloor Road will reopen to one lane of travel in each direction.**
- **Dundas Street West will have one lane of travel in each direction, north of Bloor Street West.**
- **Separated bike lanes will remain closed until all streetscape improvements are complete.**

WORK ZONE DETAILS



Motorists travelling on **Dunbloor Road** can:

- Travel **east** or **southwest** on Dundas Street West
- Travel **east** on Bloor Street West
- Access Summerland Terrace
- No left turns are permitted from northbound Dunbloor Road to Dundas Street West

Motorists travelling on **new/existing Dundas Street West** can:

- Travel **east** on Dundas Street West via Dunbloor Road
- Travel **east** on Bloor Street West
- Travel **south** on Dunbloor Road to Bloor Street AND continue **south** on the new Dundas Street West to access Kipling Avenue
- Access northbound Kipling via the Dundas-Kipling ramp

WHAT TO EXPECT DURING CONSTRUCTION

You may experience dust, noise and other inconveniences. The City will make efforts to reduce the impacts.

	Work Hours: Work will take place from 7:00 am to 7:00 pm., Monday to Friday, subject to safe weather conditions, with work after hours and on weekends are required and approved by the City.
	Road and Sidewalk access: In order to complete the work in a safe manner, there will be road and sidewalk restrictions within the construction work zone. Pedestrian access will be provided to all residents and businesses during this stage along Dunbloor Road, Dundas Street West, Summerland Terrace and Bloor Street West. Adequate signage will be placed in advance of any sidewalk restrictions. Access for emergency vehicles will be maintained at all times.
	Traffic Management: Efforts have been made to manage traffic in the area for the safety of workers, road users and residents. These efforts include adding Local Access signs, revising traffic signal times. Road users should expect delays and increased traffic on nearby streets.
