Road Reconstruction & Resurfacing on The East Mall New Sidewalk and Road Resurfacing on North Queen Street

Expected Start Date: June 2019
Expected End Date: September 2019

*Timeline is subject to change. Future notice to be provided.

The City of Toronto is planning to reconstruct The East Mall from North Queen Street to Vickers Road, and resurface The East Mall from Vickers Road to Yarn Road. The City plans to resurface North Queen Street from Vansco Road to Kipling Avenue, and construct new sidewalk on both sides of North Queen Street from Eastside Drive to The East Mall.

Our inspection of the road shows that it needs reconstruction and sections of damaged curb and sidewalk need to be replaced to bring them to a state of good repair. This work is part of the Council-approved 2019 Capital Works Program to renew aging city roads, sidewalk, and infrastructure for current and future needs.

WHAT TO EXPECT BEFORE CONSTRUCTION

- Work crews will mark sidewalks and curbs requiring replacement and the locations of underground utilities, such as gas, water and cable so that the construction work does not interfere with these utilities.
- Affected properties will receive a Construction Notice approximately two weeks before work begins
 with more information about the work.
- Work in the boulevard in front of homes and commercial properties is expected. This work includes removing and replacing driveways, municipal sidewalks and grassed boulevards, where necessary.
- Property owners should remove items located within City property limits (boulevard), such as
 landscaping and or decorative objects before work starts. If you have a sprinkler system within the
 boulevard, please contact the Project Manager listed below.




Accessible Accommodation: Residents who require accommodation (level entry, longer notice, etc.) must contact the **Project Manager** to arrange for access during the construction period.
