


Beare Hill Park – Aerial view of trail construction

The site is bounded by Finch Avenue East on the north side, Pickering Townline on the east side, the hydro corridor on the south side, and CN Rail and Beare Road on the west side. The perimeter of the site is indicated by a dashed yellow line. The trail network is shown by a solid orange line. Trails are concentrated mainly on the east side and south side of the site. The 3m wide granular surface trail largely follows the existing gravel road around the bottom of the hill at the centre of the site, and also climbs the hill to the peak. The 0.75m wide natural surface trails follow a switchback pattern to ascend the hill and join with the granular trail near the summit.
