The City of Toronto is modifying and upgrading the storm and sanitary sewer system on the streets depicted in the map on the reverse of this notice to reduce surface and basement flooding in the area.

WHAT TO EXPECT DURING CONSTRUCTION

• The community will experience dust, noise and traffic delays. Your patience is appreciated.

Ω	Traffic Management : The map on page two depicts all streets where work is taking place in the area.
8	Road users should expect delays and increased traffic on nearby main and side streets. Access for emergency vehicles will be maintained at all times.
	Please obey all construction traffic signs and barrels as placed.
걋	Pedestrians: Sidewalks will be kept open for pedestrian use. When work is taking place on the sidewalk, signage will be placed to provide information about which side of the road to use.
$\langle \cdot \rangle$	Work Hours: Work will take place from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m. , Monday to Friday, with work after hours and on weekends as required.
	Work on Jane Street: will take place from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m., Monday to Friday, within the paved areas to accommodate traffic.
	TTC: This work may affect travel times and stop locations on the 35, 935 Jane Buses and the 108 Driftwood bus. Please visit ttc.ca for accurate schedules.
G O	Cyclists: This work may affect cycle lanes in the area. Please obey signage.
