2.	Terms of Reference	 a) Final Review Feedback and commentary are being sought to review the Terms of Reference document. The intent it to amalgamate all of the changes from previous editions and create one final overarching document which will supersede all other copies and create the new precedent for matters concerning the St. Lawrence Market Precinct Advisory Committee. In Section #1 paragraph #2 – include a definitions for the term 'Precinct' to demonstrate that it represents adjoining spaces, sidewalks, open spaces, and mention of parks without overlapping Parks, Forestry & Recreations' responsibilities to those spaces. Parks can instead refer to Market Lane Park. Mention of the temporary tent must be carefully defined in order to represent its temporary nature, as part of the Complex, while also noting the permanence of its grounds, as part of the precinct. Also include a definition for the St. Lawrence Market Complex – to reflect that it refers to the building structures only. In section #4 the term 'representative' was added for continuity within the document. Strike 'Meetings are open to the public' as it is already stipulated in section #12. In Section #5 strike the term ' citizens' and replace with representative. Farmer members belong to the stakeholder category therefore the requirement for them to be residents of Toronto does not apply & no exceptions need to be noted. 	Section 1. 	 The 6 meeting minimum is a large time commitment to those wishing to participate when considering the additional time commitment of Sub-committee meetings and individual meeting with skill-based representatives. Individual meetings will also be held with members when matters arise, on an ad hoc basis, where specific feedback is required. The intention is still to have the 3rd Wednesday of every month reserved for Committee discussion, though with advance notice from St. Lawrence Market Management, the Committee will be informed as to whether or not the discussion will be moved to the Sub-committee level. Decision-Making by the City on matters concerning the Committee should not be delayed due to a reduced number of St. Lawrence Market Precinct Advisory Committee meetings, and the commitment to closing the loop on open matters is still of principal concern. In Section 11, although it is not recommended that this group vote on issues, or even that consensus be required when providing advice to the City, should the Chair require clarity on issues amongst the group, they may ask for a show of hands for or against. A definition of the working meaning of 'consensus' by this Committee may be wise to include in this section.
