
Twyn Rivers Drive Bridge Repair over Rouge River

The City of Toronto is planning to repair deteriorated steel members on the Twyn Rivers Drive Bridge over the Rouge River. This work will ensure that the bridge continues to accommodate vehicles up to the current posted limit and remains safe for vehicles and pedestrians into the future. The project is part of the Council-approved 2019 Capital Works Program.

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Construction Notice

	Work Hours : Work will take place from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m., Monday to Friday, with work after hours and on weekends as required.
÷	Road and Sidewalk Access: In order to complete the work in a safe manner, there will be road and sidewalk restrictions within the construction work area.
	Twyn Rivers Drive will be closed. Only local traffic will have access.
8	Traffic Management : Efforts have been made to manage traffic in the area for the safety of workers, road users and residents. Road users should expect delays and increased traffic on nearby main and side streets.
	Twyn Rivers Drive will be closed, with only local traffic access. A detour will be provided on Sheppard Avenue East.
R	Parking: Parking in the active work zone is not permitted due to space requirements for construction equipment and materials. If your parked vehicle affects the construction work, it will be re-located with no charge to the owner. Please contact parking control for the location of your vehicle at 416-808-2222 .
	Restoration: The construction work area will be restored with sod and/or asphalt where required. Interlocking bricks, flagstone on a granular base, or other similar features that are removed during construction will be replaced.
Ġ	Accessible Accommodation: Residents who require accommodation (level entry, longer notice, clear sidewalk path etc.) must contact the Project Manager to arrange for access during the construction period.
