## Dundas Street West at Islington Avenue Bridge Rehabilitation over Mimico Creek

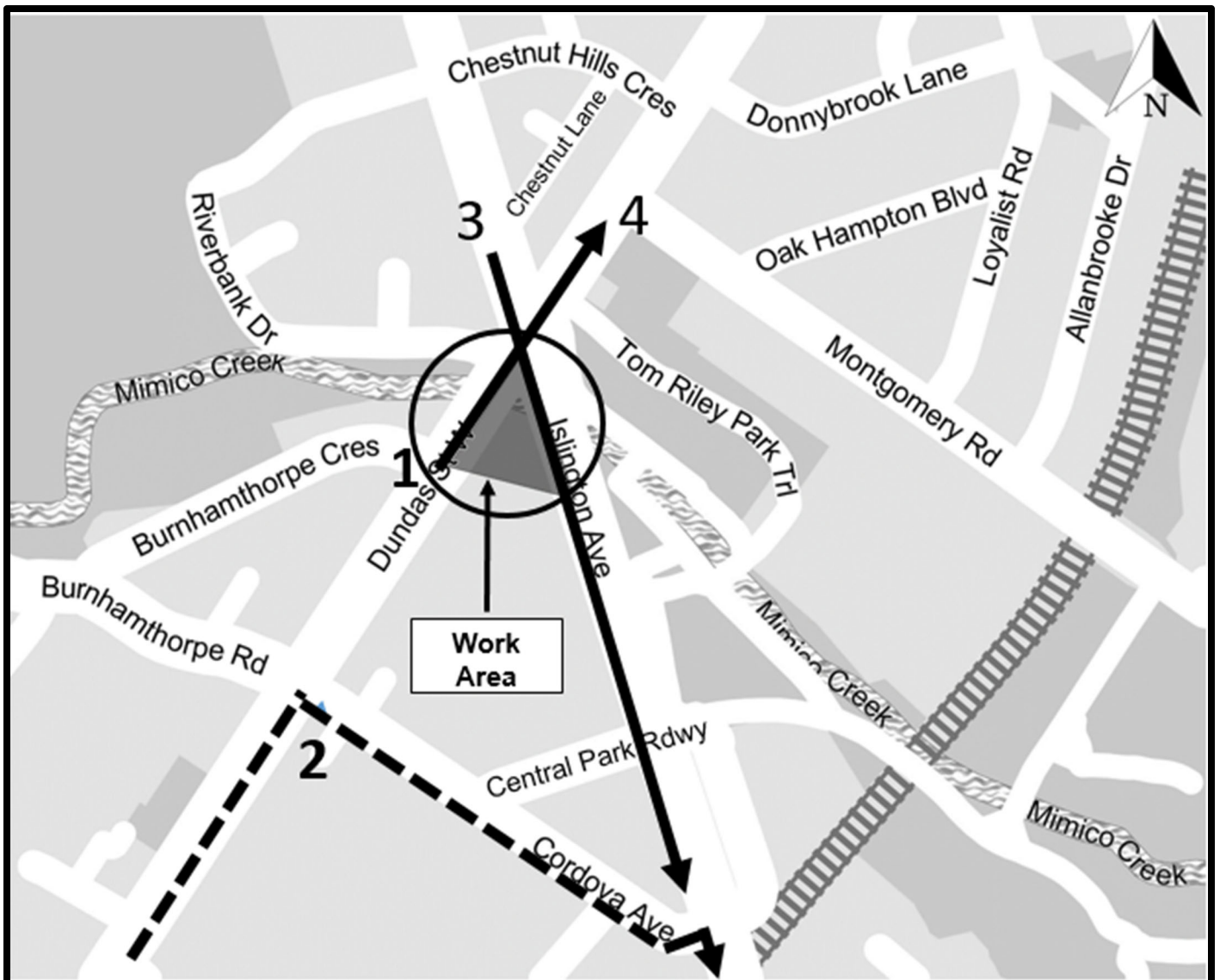
**Expected Start Date: April 5, 2019**

The City of Toronto is rehabilitating the Dundas Street West at Islington Avenue Bridge over Mimico Creek on weekends in March and April 2019. This work will ensure that the bridge meets today's standards and remains safe for vehicles and pedestrians into the future. The project is part of the Council-approved 2019 Capital Works Program.

### MAP OF WORK AREA



1. The right turn lane from Dundas Street West eastbound to Islington Avenue southbound will be closed
2. Motorists travelling eastbound along Dundas Street West wishing to turn southbound are advised to do so at Cordova Avenue
3. One southbound lane on Islington Avenue from Chestnut Lane to Central Park Roadway will be closed; motorists will still be able to make a right and left turn onto Dundas Street West and a left turn onto Chestnut Lane
4. One eastbound lane on Dundas Street West from Burnhamthorpe Crescent to Montgomery Road will be closed; motorists will be able to make a turn onto Montgomery Road







## WORK DETAILS

The City's contractor will:

- Replace the asphalt and concrete on the deck and the approach slab

## WHAT TO EXPECT DURING CONSTRUCTION

- You may experience dust, noise and other inconveniences. The City will make efforts to reduce impacts. We appreciate your patience.

	<p><b>Work Hours:</b> Work will take place on two weekends - April 5 and April 13 - starting at 8 p.m. each Friday until 5 a.m. each Monday.</p>
	<p><b>Road and Sidewalk Access:</b> All sidewalks at the intersection of Dundas Street West and Islington Avenue will be accessible to pedestrians.</p>
	<p><b>Traffic Management:</b> Efforts have been made to manage traffic in the area for the safety of workers, road users and residents. Road users should expect delays and increased traffic on nearby main and side streets.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• One southbound lane on Islington Avenue through the work zone will be closed.</li> <li>• The right turn lane from Dundas Street West eastbound to Islington Avenue southbound will be closed.</li> </ul>
	<p><b>Transit Service:</b> This project may affect Mississauga Transit travel routes that travel along Dundas and turn south onto Islington. 	<p><b>Restoration:</b> The construction work area will be restored with sod and/or asphalt where required. Interlocking bricks, flagstone on a granular base, or other similar features that are removed during construction will be replaced.</p>
	<p><b>Accessible Accommodation:</b> Residents who require accommodation (level entry, longer notice, clear sidewalk path etc.) must contact the <b>Project Manager</b> to arrange for access during the construction period.</p>
