Noise Barrier Wall Installation at Don Valley Parkway and Spanbridge Road

Contract: 18ECS-TI-10BE Expected Start Date: Spring 2019 Expected End Date: Fall 2019 *Timeline is subject to change. Future notice to be provided.

The City of Toronto is planning to install a noise barrier wall on the west side of Don Valley Parkway at Spanbridge Road. This work is part of the Council-approved 2019 Capital Works Program and will ensure that the sound levels from the parkway to nearby residences are reduced to meet sound level limits.

WHAT TO EXPECT BEFORE CONSTRUCTION

- Work crews will mark walkways and grassed areas with the locations of underground utilities, such as gas, water and cable so that the construction work does not interfere with these utilities.
- Affected properties will receive a Construction Notice approximately two weeks before work begins with more information about the work.

Ġ	Accessible Accommodation: Residents who require accommodation (level entry, longer notice, clear sidewalk path etc.) must contact the Project Manager to arrange for access during the construction period.
÷	Sidewalk Access: In order to complete the work in a safe manner, there will be access restrictions along sections of the south sidewalk on Spanbridge Road. Please note that the sidewalk on the north side of Spanbridge Road will be open for the entire project. Further details on the restrictions and staging will be provided in the Construction Notice.
