Gardiner Expressway Substructure Repairs from Spadina Avenue and the Rees Street On Ramp

Contract: 19ECS-TI-01GE
Expected Start Date: April 2019
Expected End Date: December 31, 2019

As a result of a recent inspection, the City of Toronto is expediting work to repair the areas (bents and piers) underneath the Gardiner between Spadina Avenue and Dan Leckie Way, and Lower Simcoe Street and Rees Street.

Bents are steel reinforced concrete columns and horizontal pier caps which the concrete deck sits on. Piers are the reinforced concrete columns to support the deck. This work will not affect the roadway.

This work was originally planned for 2023 as part of the Gardiner Expressway Rehabilitation Strategy, but is being expedited to ensure the Gardiner Expressway remains in a safe and operable condition.

	<p>Accessible Accommodation: Residents who require accommodation (level entry, longer notice, clear sidewalk path etc.) must contact the Project Manager to arrange for access during the construction period.</p>
