

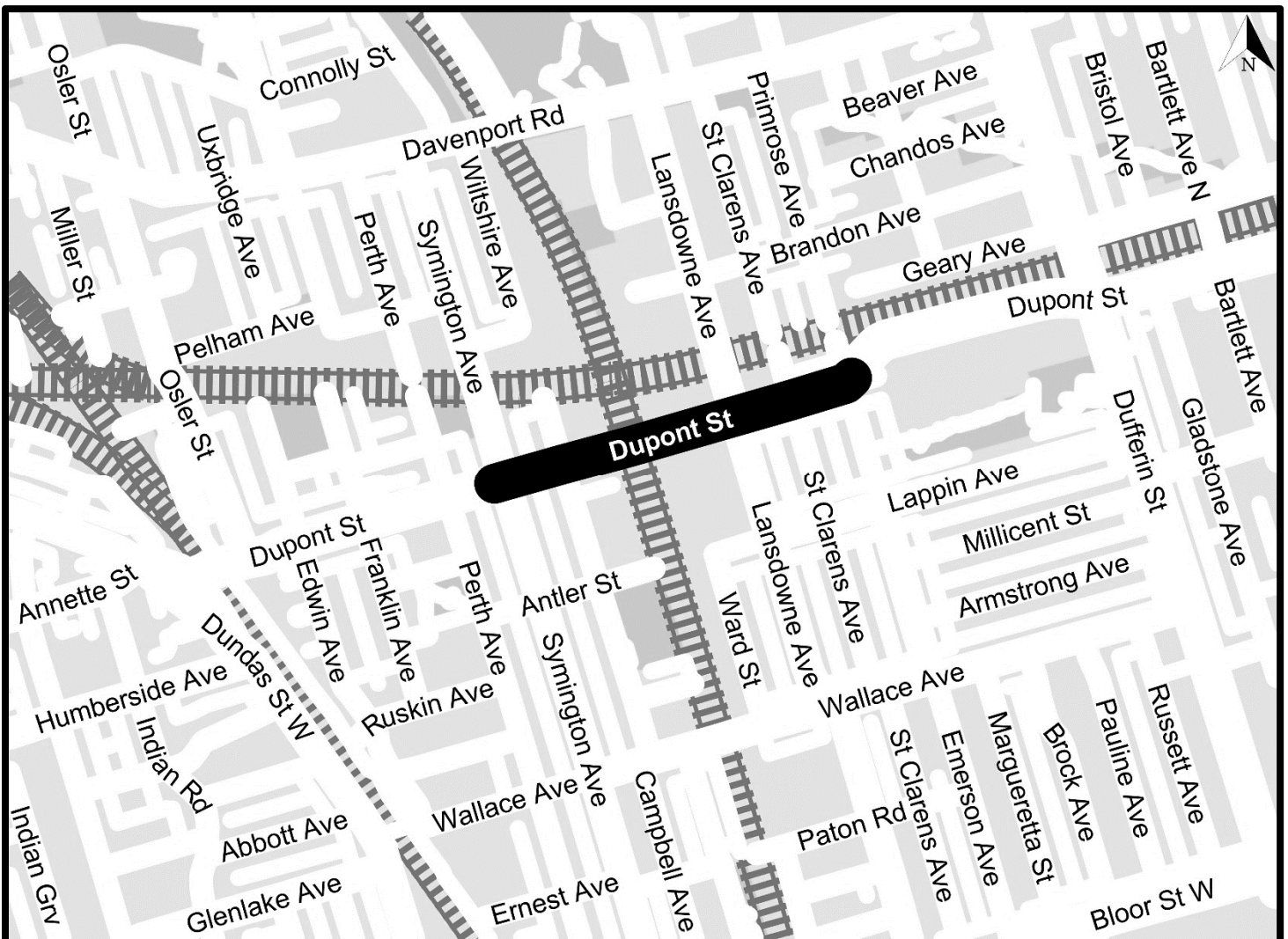

## Dupont Street Bridge Rehabilitation in Vicinity of Metrolinx Tracks

**Contract: 17ECS-TI-07BE**  
**Expected Start Date: April 16, 2019**  
**Expected End Date: May 22, 2019**  
*\*Timeline is subject to change.*

The City of Toronto is planning to rehabilitate Dupont Street Bridge under Metrolinx Tracks between Symington Avenue and Lansdowne Avenue. This work will ensure that the bridge meets today's standards and remains safe for vehicles and pedestrians into the future. The project is part of the Council-approved 2019 Capital Works Program.

### WORK DETAILS

The City's contractor will move equipment on-site and prepare the work area before construction begins. Construction crews will then:

- Repair sidewalk
- Repair deck (asphalt and concrete)

### WHAT TO EXPECT DURING CONSTRUCTION

- You may experience dust, noise and other inconveniences. The City will make efforts to reduce impacts. We appreciate your patience.

	<p><b>Work Hours:</b> Work will take place from 7a.m to 7 p.m., Monday to Friday, with work after hours and on weekends as required.</p>
	<p><b>Road and Sidewalk Access:</b> In order to complete the work in a safe manner, there will be road and sidewalk restrictions within the construction work area. The work will require sidewalk closures along Dupont, however sidewalk closures will alternate in each direction to ensure pedestrian access is maintained during construction.</p>
	<p><b>Traffic Management:</b> Efforts have been made to manage traffic in the area for the safety of workers, road users and residents. Road users should expect delays and increased traffic on nearby main and side streets.</p> <p><b>The work will require both westbound and eastbound lanes along Dupont to be narrowed and shared with cyclists, and will alternate depending on which side of the street work is taking place.</b></p>
	<p><b>Parking:</b> Parking in the active work zone is not permitted due to space requirements for construction equipment and materials. If your parked vehicle affects the construction work, it will be re-located with no charge to the owner. Please contact parking control for the location of your vehicle at <b>416-808-2222</b>.</p>
	<p><b>TTC Service:</b> This project may affect travel times on the 26 Dupont bus route. Visit <a href="http://ttc.ca">ttc.ca</a> for schedule information.</p>
	<p><b>Restoration:</b> The construction work area will be restored with sod and/or asphalt where required. Interlocking bricks, flagstone on a granular base, or other similar features that are removed during construction will be replaced.</p>
