### Bridge Rehabilitation on Donino Avenue over West Don River

Expected Start Date: Summer 2019 Expected End Date: Fall 2019

\*Timeline is subject to change. Future notice to be provided.

The City of Toronto is planning to rehabilitate the Donino Avenue Bridge over West Don River. This work will ensure that the bridge meets today's standards and remains safe for vehicles and pedestrians into the future. The work also includes replacing and relocating the watermain that is currently attached to the bridge. The project is part of the Council-approved 2019 Capital Works Program to renew aging infrastructure and bring it to a state of good repair.

Donino Avenue will be closed at the bridge location. A signed detour around the site will use Donwoods Drive, Plymbridge Road, Plymbridge Crescent and Brookfield Road. Alternatively, Ivor Road or Donwoods Drive, Yonge Street and Mill Street can also be used to access the areas north and south of the bridge.

### **Pre-Construction Notice**

#### WHAT TO EXPECT BEFORE CONSTRUCTION

- Work crews will mark sidewalks and the road with the locations of underground utilities, such as gas, water and cable so that the construction work does not interfere with these utilities.
- Affected properties will receive a Construction Notice approximately two weeks before work begins with more information about the work.
- Work in the boulevard in front of homes is expected. This work includes removing and replacing municipal sidewalks and grassed boulevards, where necessary.
- Property owners should remove items located within City property limits (boulevard), such as landscaping and or decorative objects before work starts. If you have a sprinkler system within the boulevard, please contact the Project Manager listed below.

Ġ	Accessible Accommodation: Residents who require accommodation (level entry, longer notice, clear sidewalk path etc.) must contact the <b>Project Manager</b> to arrange for access during the construction period.
R R R R R R R R R R	Access to Your Home: The City-hired contractor may need access to your home to complete a pre-construction survey. Affected properties will receive a pre-construction survey request to schedule a time to complete the survey.
•	<b>Road and Sidewalk Access:</b> In order to complete the work in a safe and efficient manner, Donino Avenue will be closed at the bridge location. A signed detour will be in place. The detour around the site will use Donwoods Drive, Plymbridge Road, Plymbridge Crescent and Brookfield Road. Alternatively, Ivor Road or Donwoods Drive, Yonge Street and Mill Street can also be used to access the areas north and south of the bridge.
