Road Reconstruction on Glen Road

Contract: 18ECS-TI-19LR Start Date: April 23, 2019 End Date: October 31, 2019 *Timelines are subject to change.

The City of Toronto will reconstruct Glen Road from Beaumont Road to Summerhill Avenue and from Summerhill Avenue to 337 Glen Road in three phases of work. At all times during construction, one northbound lane of traffic will be maintained on Glen Road.

WHAT TO EXPECT DURING CONSTRUCTION

• The community will experience dust, noise and traffic delays. We appreciate your patience.

8	 Traffic Management: Efforts have been made to manage traffic in the area for the safety of workers, road users and residents. Road users should expect delays and increased traffic on nearby main and side streets. Traffic on Glen Road will be reduced to one northbound lane during the project. Please refer to maps below showing traffic management during each phase of work.
	TTC Service: This project may affect travel times on the 82 Rosedale bus; visit ttc.ca for accurate schedule information. Some bus stop locations may be temporarily re-located along Glen Road during construction.
汴	Pedestrians: Sidewalk access will be maintained on one side of the road during construction. Signage will be placed to provide information about which side of the road to use.

PHASES WORK AREAS AND TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT

Phase One April 23 to June 15, from Beaumont Road to Whitney Avenue

- Westbound traffic on Beaumont Road will be able to make left and right turns onto Glen Road.
- Eastbound traffic on Highland Avenue will be able to make left and right turns onto Glen Road.
- Traffic from Bin-Scarth Road, Edgar Avenue and Whitney Avenue will only be able to make northbound turns onto Glen Road.
- East /west travel will be permitted across Glen Road.
- During construction work at the Beaumont Road and Glen Road intersection, a temporary traffic signal will be in place to allow for northbound and southbound traffic movement along Glen Road.

Phase Two June 17 to August 16, from Whitney Avenue to Summerhill Avenue



- Westbound traffic on Whitney Avenue will be able to make left and right turns onto Glen Road.
- Eastbound traffic on Glen Road will be able to make left and right turns onto Glen Road.
- Traffic from Roxborough Drive and Douglas Drive can only make northbound turns onto Glen Road.
- No right turns from eastbound Summerhill Avenue onto Glen Road.
- Traffic travelling west on Glen Road will not be permitted to make a left turn onto Glen Road.

Phase Three August 19 to October 31, north of Summerhill to 337 Glen Road



- Westbound traffic on Douglas Drive will be able to make a right turn onto Glen Road.
- Eastbound traffic on Glen Road will be able to make a left turn onto Glen Road.
- The lane at the north end of Glen Road will be open to one way (northeast) traffic to allow for local traffic to exit the construction area.
