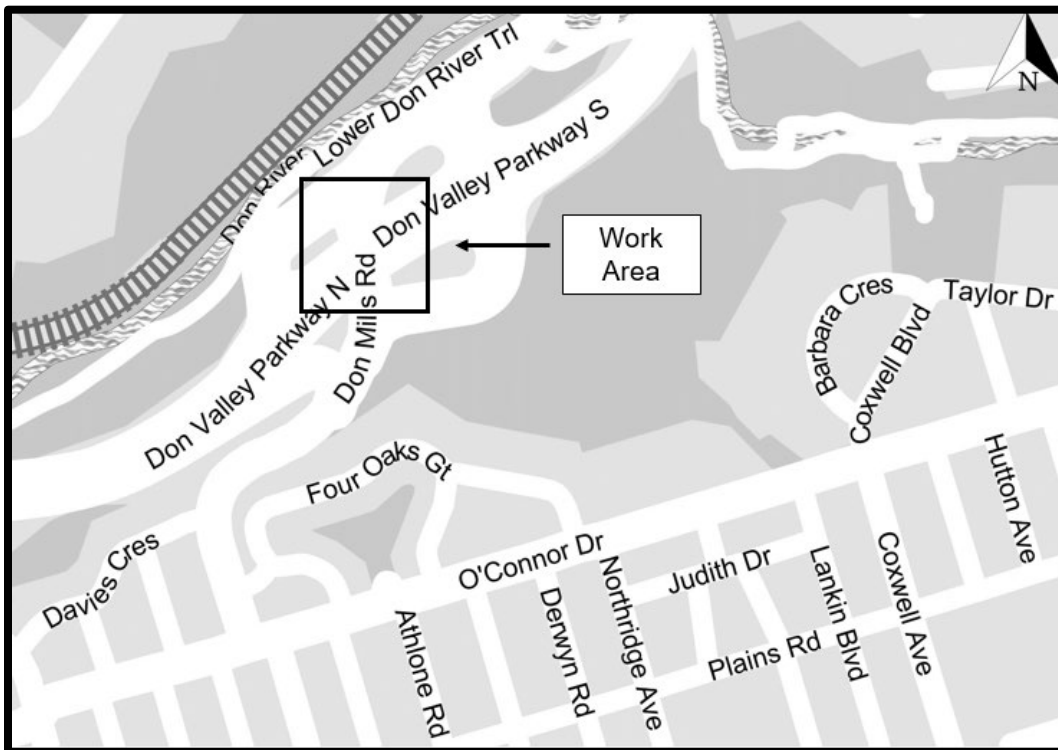

The City of Toronto is planning to rehabilitate the sub-structure (underneath the road) of the Don Mills Road Bridge over the Don Valley Parkway in the summer of 2019, and the super-structure (road level) of the bridge in 2020. This work will ensure that the bridge meets today's standards and remains safe for vehicles and pedestrians into the future. The project is part of the Council-approved 2019 Capital Works Program.

WHAT TO EXPECT BEFORE CONSTRUCTION

- Work crews will mark sidewalks and the road with the locations of underground utilities, such as gas, water and cable so that the construction work does not interfere with these utilities.
- Affected properties will receive a Construction Notice approximately two weeks before work begins with more information about the work.
