Bridge Rehabilitation Islington Avenue over Humber River

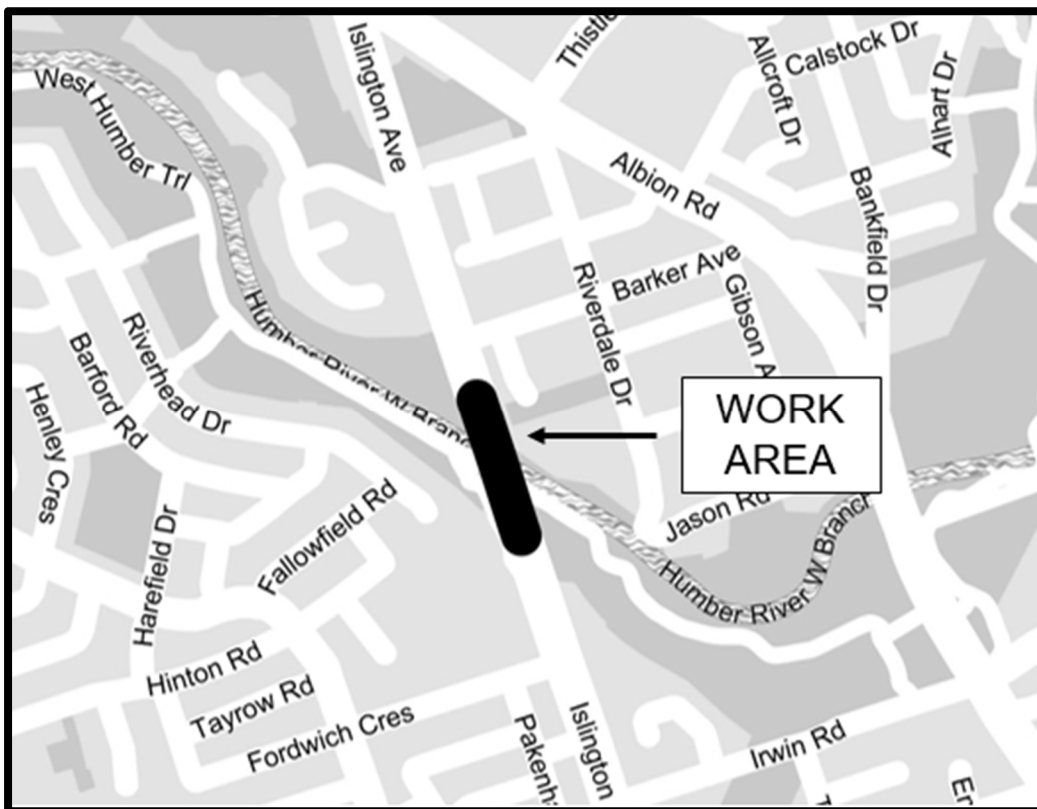

The City of Toronto is planning to rehabilitate the Islington Avenue bridge over the Humber River, south of Albion Road. This work will ensure that the bridge meets today's standards and remains safe for vehicles and pedestrians into the future. The project is part of the Council-approved 2019 Capital Works Program.

WHAT TO EXPECT BEFORE CONSTRUCTION

- Work crews will mark sidewalks and the road with the locations of underground utilities, such as gas, water and cable so that the construction work does not interfere with these utilities.
- Affected properties will receive a Construction Notice approximately two weeks before work begins with more information about the work.



Accessible Accommodation: Residents who require accommodation (level entry, longer notice, clear sidewalk path etc) must contact the **Project Manager** to arrange for access during the construction period.
