To obtain authority to enter into a licence agreement with Metrolinx (the "Agreement"), over part of 625-641 Eglinton Purpose Avenue West, required for the implementation of the Eglinton-Scarborough Crosstown Light Rail Transit Project (the "Project"). Property Part of 625-641 Eglinton Avenue West, shown as Part 6 on Dwg. No. ECLE1-2G-SK020\_1A (the "Licensed Area") in Appendix "A". 1. Authority be granted to enter into the Agreement, for construction purposes, on terms and conditions as set out Actions herein and as deemed appropriate by the DCM, CS or his/her designate, and in a form satisfactory to the City Solicitor: The DCM, CS or his/her designate be authorized to administer and manage the Agreement including the provision 2. of any consent, approvals, waivers, amendments, notices and notices of termination provided that the DCM, CS may, at any time, refer consideration of such matter to City Council for its determination and direction. 3 The appropriate City Officials be authorized and directed to take the necessary action to give effect thereto. There is no financial impact resulting from this approval. **Financial Impact** Pursuant to Schedule F (Real Estate Protocol) contained in the Master Agreement between the City, the Toronto Transit Commission and Metrolinx for the implementation of the Toronto Light Rail Transit Program dated November 28, 2012 ("Master Agreement"), temporary use property requirements not required for City purposes are transferred to Metrolinx for nominal consideration. The Chief Financial Officer and Treasurer has reviewed this DAF and agrees with the financial impact information. Metrolinx has requested for a temporary licence over the the Licensed Area, for construction purposes, for a term of Comments twenty four (24) months, commencing on the date that the agreement is executed.
