## Laneway Reconstruction East of Yonge Street South of Price Street

**Expected Start Date: August 2019**

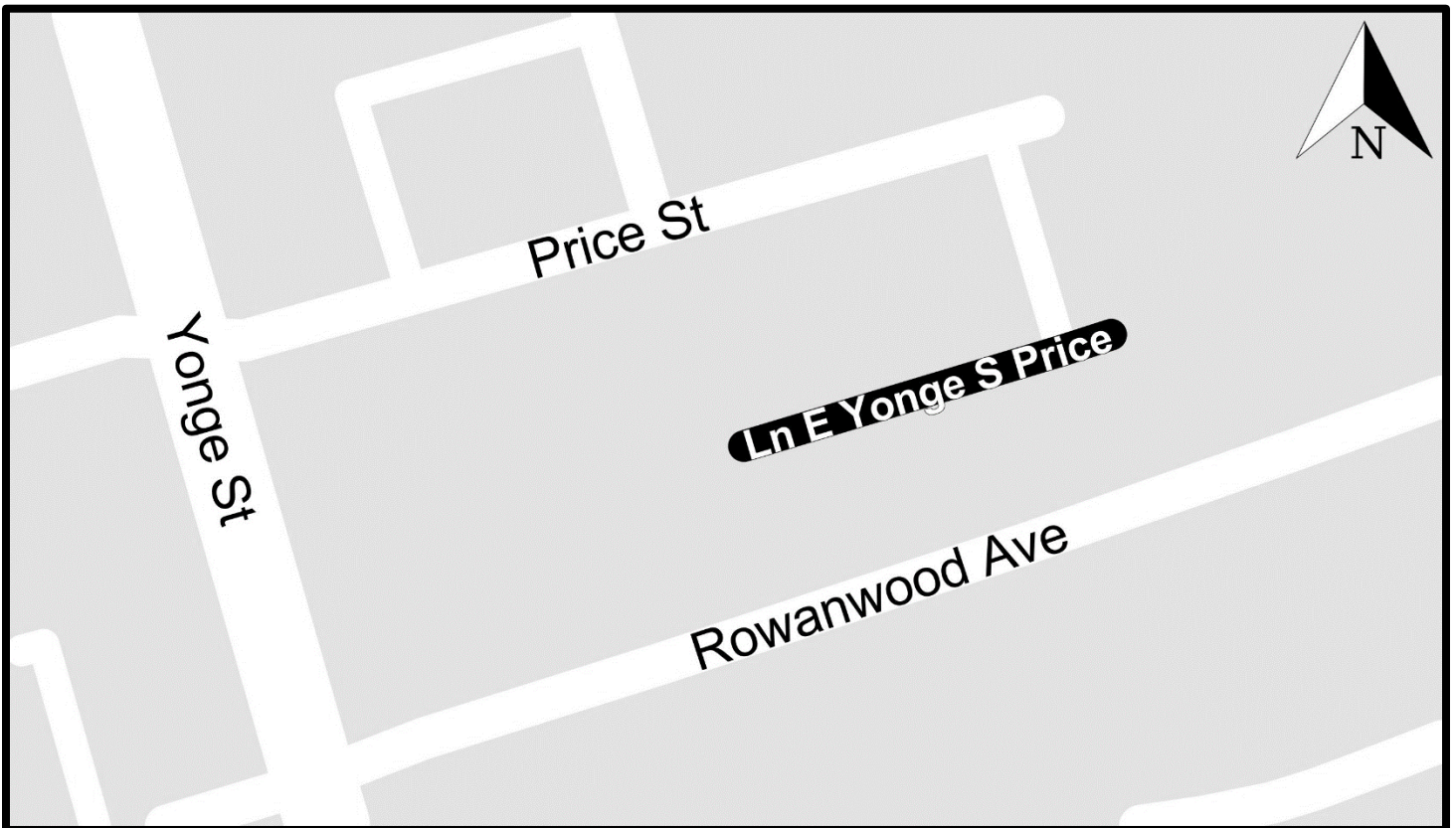
**Expected End Date: December 2019**

The City of Toronto is planning to reconstruct the laneway east of Yonge Street and south of Price Street and will be installing an infiltration catch basin at the west end of the laneway. Our inspection of the laneway shows that it needs reconstruction to bring it to a state of good repair.


This work is part of the Council-approved 2019 Capital Works Program to renew aging city roads and laneways for current and future needs.

## WHAT TO EXPECT BEFORE CONSTRUCTION

- Work crews will mark the locations of underground utilities, such as gas, water and cable so that the construction work does not interfere with these utilities.
- Affected properties will receive a Construction Notice approximately two weeks before work begins with more information about the work.
- Property owners should remove items located within City property limits such as landscaping and or decorative objects before work starts. The City will not be responsible for damage to any privately-owned items on City property.

	<p><b>Accessible Accommodation:</b> Residents who require accommodation (level entry, longer notice, etc.) must contact the <b>Project Manager</b> to arrange for access during the construction period.</p>
