Summary of Decisions

1. Hafizullah Ghulam Nabi (Report No. 7157)

Holder of Vehicle-For-Hire Driver's Licence No. D01-4808856

DECISION:

The Tribunal approved the joint Proposed Resolution.

Vehicle-For-Hire Driver's Licence will be subject to the following conditions:

- (1) Vehicle-For-Hire Driver's Licence will be placed on probation for a period of one (1) year. Mr. Ghulam Nabi is advised that during the probationary period, MLS may make additional checks of any driving, criminal, and by-law charges and convictions against Mr. Ghulam Nabi and conduct other investigations, as appropriate, to assess Mr. Ghulam Nabi's compliance with the requirements of Chapter 546 of the Municipal Code and other applicable laws;
- (2) During the probationary period, if Municipal Licensing and Standards has concerns with any new charges or convictions against Mr. Ghulam Nabi or any other concerns with respect to the conduct of the licensee, those matters and report No. 7157 and any updating material, may be brought back before the Tribunal for a full hearing.

2. Niroshan Chandraruban (Report No. 7199)

DECISION:

The Tribunal approved the joint Proposed Resolution.

Tow Truck Driver's Licence will be renewed, subject to the following conditions:

- (1) All fees, documents and/or any outstanding requirements must be submitted to the satisfaction of Municipal Licensing and Standards within 30 days of the Tribunal hearing, failing which the licence may be cancelled;

- (2) Immediately upon being renewed, Tow Truck Driver's Licence will be placed on probation for a period of one (1) year. Mr. Chandraruban is advised that during the probationary period, MLS may make additional checks of any driving, criminal, and by-law charges and convictions against Mr. Chandraruban and conduct other investigations, as appropriate, to assess Mr. Chandraruban's compliance with the requirements of Chapter 545 of the Municipal Code and other applicable laws;
- (3) During the probationary period, if Municipal Licensing and Standards has concerns with any new charges or convictions against Mr. Chandraruban or any other concerns with respect to the conduct of the licensee, those matters and report No. 7199 and any updating material, may be brought back before the Tribunal for a full hearing.

3. Mohammed A. Malik (Report No. 7154)

Applicant for the Renewal of Vehicle-For-Hire Driver's Licence No. D01-4072128

DECISION:

The Tribunal approved the joint Proposed Resolution.

Vehicle-For-Hire Driver's Licence will be renewed, subject to the following conditions:

- (1) All fees, documents and/or any outstanding requirements must be submitted to the satisfaction of Municipal Licensing and Standards within 30 days of the Tribunal hearing, failing which the licence may be cancelled;
- (2) Immediately upon being renewed, Vehicle-For-Hire Driver's Licence will be placed on probation for a period of two (2) years. Mr. Malik is advised that during the probationary period, MLS may make additional checks of any driving, criminal, and by-law charges and convictions against Mr. Malik and conduct other investigations, as appropriate, to assess Mr. Malik's compliance with the requirements of Chapter 546 of the Municipal Code and other applicable laws;
- (3) During the probationary period, if Municipal Licensing and Standards has concerns with any new charges or convictions against Mr. Malik or any other concerns with respect to the conduct of the licensee, those matters and report No. 7154 and any updating material, may be brought back before the Tribunal for a full hearing.

- (3) Body Rub Parlour Owner/Operator Licence will be placed on probation for a period of three (3) years.
