
Watermain Replacement on Lipton Avenue from East of Pape Avenue

Contract: 18ECS-LU-12SU
Original Start Date: April 2, 2019
Original End Date: Late May, 2019
NEW Start Date: June 11, 2019
NEW End Date: Fall 2019
*Timeline is subject to change.

In February 2019, the City of Toronto issued a Construction Notice regarding upcoming watermain replacement work on Lipton Avenue east of Pape Avenue. Due to unforeseen circumstances with project scheduling, work on Lipton Avenue will now begin on June 11, 2019 and be completed in Fall 2019 (including permanent restorations).

We recognize that a project of this nature is disruptive to the community and apologize for the inconveniences caused by the delayed start and end date.

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WHAT TO EXPECT DURING CONSTRUCTION

- You may experience dust, noise and other inconveniences. The City will make efforts to reduce the impacts. We appreciate your patience.
- Property owners should remove items located within City property limits (boulevard), such as landscaping and / or decorative objects.
- The City will not be responsible for damage to any privately owned items on City property.



Work Hours: Work will take place from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m., Monday to Friday, with work after hours and on weekends as required.



Road and Sidewalk Access: In order to complete the work in a safe manner, there will be road and sidewalk restrictions within the construction work zone. Access for emergency vehicles will be maintained at all times.

Driveway Access: The contractor will notify you of any temporary restrictions to your driveway access. If your property has two entrances, one entrance will be kept open at all times.



Traffic Management: Efforts have been made to manage traffic in the area for the safety of workers, road users and residents. Road users should expect delays and increased traffic on nearby main and side streets.

Traffic on Lipton Avenue will be reduced to one lane.



Parking: On-Street parking will be unavailable during construction within the work zone.

Parking in the active work zone is not permitted due to space requirements for construction equipment and materials. If your parked vehicle affects the construction work, it will be re-located with no charge to the owner. If your vehicle is moved, please contact parking control for its location at **416-808-2222.**

In the event you receive a traffic ticket for on-street parking during this period of construction, you may choose to dispute your ticket following the process listed on the reverse side of the parking infraction notice. You may use this notice as part of your defence for parking consideration during construction; however, the Project Manager does not have the authority to cancel any parking tickets.



Garbage & Recycling: Please follow your normal routine. If required, the contractor will move bins to an appropriate location and return them.

Please ensure that you label your bins with your address.



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Restoration: The construction work area will be restored with sod and/or asphalt where required. Interlocking bricks, flagstone on a granular base, or other similar features that are removed from public and private property during construction will be replaced. Lawn seeding and/or laying of sod will be done as needed during ideal growing seasons only in the spring (April to June) and fall (September to October).
