

The City of Toronto is planning to rehabilitate Bayview Avenue Bridge Rehabilitation over West Don River. This work will ensure that the bridge meets today's standards and remains safe for vehicles and pedestrians into the future. The project is part of the Council-approved 2019 Capital Works Program.
