Your Planning Table will be asking you to present your project idea before filling out the online application for the grant. Be prepared to briefly describe your project to the Planning Table, including why you think this project is a good idea and how it will help to improve your neighbourhood.

What is your group name?	
Does your group have at least three members that live in separate households in an NIA?	
What is the name of your project?	
Is your project designed to <u>directly</u> reduce harmful emissions or <u>indirectly</u> (education)? Ex: walking challenge (direct) or education on climate change (indirect)	
Is the project community-led?	
Who can participate in your project?	
How many community members can be engaged with your project?	
How will community members find out about your project?	
Can your project be completed within 3 months of starting?

What the Planning Table May Ask You:	Answer:
In which neighbourhood will the activity/project be based?	
What is your approximate budget?	
What is the approximate amount you will be requesting from the grant?	
Have you secured a trustee? Ex: an agency partner who will administer the funds and act as a supportive mentor to your project.
