Road Reconstruction on Morningside Avenue West of South Kingsway

Contract 18ECS-TI-04LR

Expected Start Date: Late August, 2019 Expected End Date: October 28, 2019 *Timeline is subject to change. Future notice to be provided.

The City's work to reconstruct the road and replace the City-owned portion of substandard water services on Morningside Avenue west of South Kingsway will start soon.

This work is part of the Council-approved Capital Works Program to renew aging city roads and sidewalk for current and future needs.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION ABOUT LEAD WATER SERVICES

The water service is the underground pipe that brings water to your water meter and is owned by you <u>and</u> by the City. The part you own is from your house to the end of your property, the part the City owns is from the end of your property to the watermain.

If you live on Morningside Avenue west of South Kingsway in a house that was built before the mid-1950s, your water service may be made of lead. Please read the attached fact sheet with important information about the risks of lead in drinking water, especially if someone in your house is pregnant, there are children under six years old, or there is an infant drinking formula made using tap water.

WORK DETAILS

The City's contractor will:

- Complete surveys and inspections, utility locates
- Dig up the road surface
- Replace any City-owned water service pipes that do not meet City standards from the watermain to the private property line
- Adjust maintenance holes and catch basins
- Replace the granular road base
- Install rolled curbs and gutters on both sides of the road
- Repave the road surface
- Restore driveway portion impacted by construction

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	Work Hours: Work will take place from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m., Monday to Friday. Notice will be provided if work is required after hours or on Saturdays.	
명 	Pre-Construction Inspection: Wristen's Home Specialties (WHS) under contract to the City of Toronto, will survey all properties within 30 metres of the construction area before construction starts. Participation in the survey is voluntary; however, participating is important in determining if the construction caused damage. The inspection will look at both the interior and exterior of all properties to verify existing conditions. The company will deliver a separate notice requesting time to set up appointments. All inspection staff will wear photo identification and carry photographic equipment during their work.	
Ling	Substandard Water Service Replacement: Please take the time to read the attached fact sheet carefully as it contains important information on lead in drinking water and how to prepare for replacement. If you want to replace your part of the water service pipe, contact the City's contractor for one of your quotes.

<u>aa aa</u>	This includes items such as landscaping (plants and pavers), decorative objects, sprinkler systems or heated driveways. If you have a sprinkler system or heated driveway, please contact the Public Consultation Unit listed below.	

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(\mathbb{R})	Parking: Parking in the active work zone is not permitted due to space requirements for construction equipment and materials. If your parked vehicle affects the construction work, it will be re-located with no charge to the owner. If your vehicle is moved, please contact parking control for its location at 416-808-2222 .
	In the event you receive a traffic ticket for on-street parking during this period of construction, you may choose to dispute your ticket following the process listed on the reverse side of the parking infraction notice. You may use this notice as part of your defence for parking consideration during construction; however, the Public Consultation Unit does not have the authority to cancel any parking tickets.
	Garbage & Recycling: Please follow your normal routine. If required, the contractor will move bins to an appropriate location and return them. <i>Please ensure that you label your bins with your address.</i>
	Restoration: The construction work area will be restored with sod and/or asphalt where required. Interlocking bricks, flagstone on a granular base, or other similar features that are removed from public and private property during construction will be replaced. Lawn seeding and/or laying of sod will be done as needed during ideal growing seasons only - in the spring (April to June) and fall (September to October).
