## Bridge Rehabilitation Rathburn Road over Mimico Creek

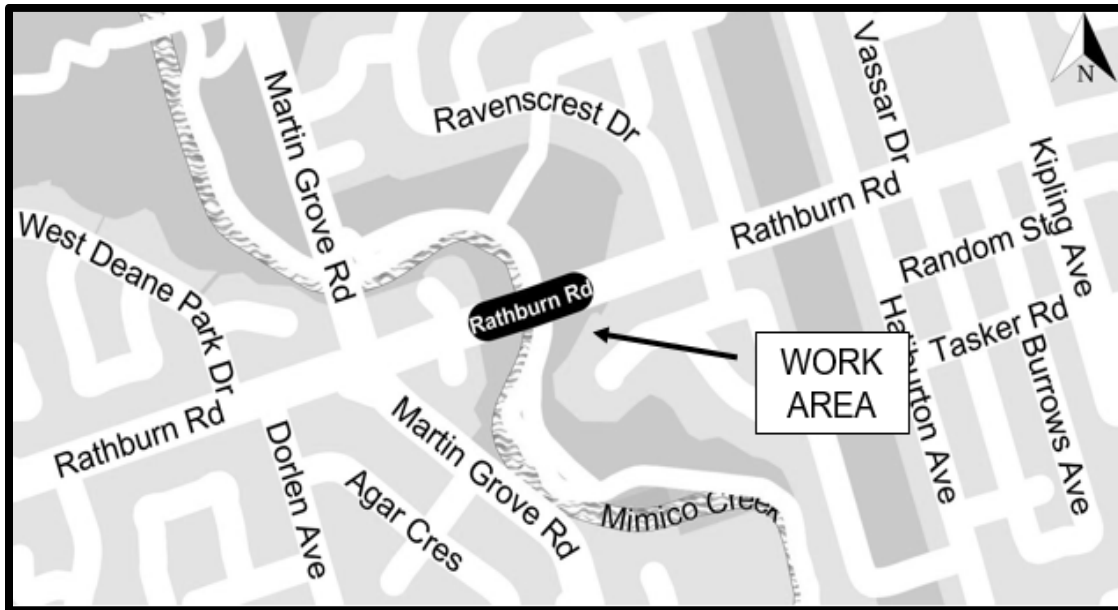
**Expected Start Date: May 2019\***

The City of Toronto will rehabilitate the Rathburn Road Bridge over Mimico Creek, between Martin Grove Road and Ravenscrest Drive. This work will ensure that the bridge meets today's standards and remains safe for vehicles and pedestrians into the future. The project is part of the Council-approved 2019 Capital Works Program.

### WORK DETAILS

The City's contractor will:

- Reconstruct the concrete bridge sidewalk
- Patch repair the concrete deck, abutments, wingwalls and piers
- Replace the bridge bearings, expansion joints, asphalt surface and waterproofing
- Construct new parapet wall and new handrail
- Improve the road drainage and bridge approaches

## WHAT TO EXPECT DURING CONSTRUCTION

- You may experience dust, noise and other inconveniences. The City will make efforts to reduce impacts. We appreciate your patience.

	<p><b>Work Hours:</b> Monday to Friday: 7 a.m. to 11 p.m., Saturdays and Sundays: 9 a.m. to 7p.m. Statutory Holidays: No work</p>
	<p><b>Road and Sidewalk Access:</b> In order to complete the work in a safe manner, there will be road and sidewalk restrictions within the construction work area.</p> <p>At least one sidewalk along the bridge will remain open at all times. Temporary signage will direct pedestrians to temporary signalled crosswalks to safely cross the road. Site notices will inform pedestrians on sidewalk accessibility.</p>
	<p><b>Traffic Management:</b> Efforts have been made to manage traffic in the area for the safety of workers, road users and residents. Road users should expect delays and increased traffic on nearby main and side streets.</p> <p><b>One lane in each direction along Rathburn Road will be maintained throughout construction.</b></p> <p>The bike lane on the bridge will be closed and cyclists will be required to share the road along the bridge. The lanes will be shifted to the north half of the bridge first, then shifted to the south half of the bridge during construction work.</p>
	<p><b>Restoration:</b> Areas affected by construction will be restored.</p>
