Watermain and Sidewalk Replacement, Permanent Cycling Facilities, Streetscaping and New Parkettes on Bloor Street West from Bathurst Street to Spadina Avenue

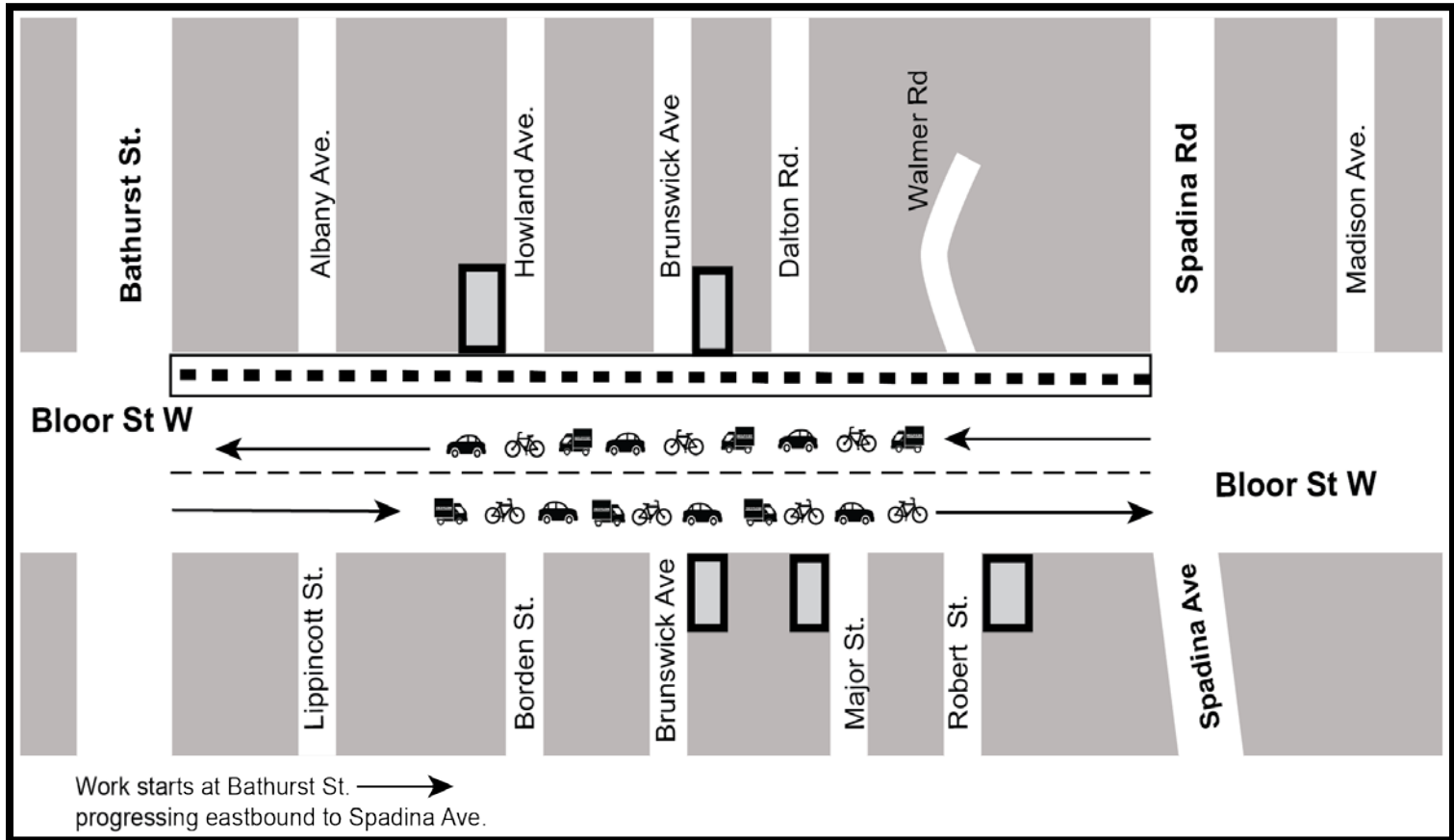

The City's contractor is making excellent progress installing the new watermain along Bloor Street West. The watermain has been installed and has passed testing. The City will now transfer the water service connections from the old watermain to the new watermain.

Connections with minimal disruption (i.e. water shut offs) to businesses and residents will be performed during the day. Connections that require longer water shut offs will be performed at night to minimize the disruption of having no water. Nighttime working hours are from 11:00 PM to 7:00 AM. The City's contractor will attempt to accommodate each properties' preference for the timing of their connection.

Businesses/residents will be given a minimum 48 hours' notice for planned water shut offs. Although all efforts will be taken to minimize noise, there will be construction noise during these hours.

WHAT TO EXPECT DURING CONSTRUCTION

You will experience dust, noise and other inconveniences. The City will make efforts to reduce impacts. Your patience is appreciated.

	<p>Work Hours: Regular hours of work remain 7:00 AM to 11:00PM Monday to Friday and 9:00 AM to 7:00PM on Saturdays with work on Sundays when required.</p> <p>Night work will be scheduled from 11:00 PM to 7:00 AM when required for water service connections.</p>
	<p>Traffic Management: Efforts have been made to manage traffic in the area for the safety of workers, road users and residents. Road users should continue to obey all posted traffic signage.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • There will be one shared lane in each direction for vehicles and bicycles through the work zone
 	<p>Road and Sidewalk Access: In order to complete the work in a safe manner, there will be road and sidewalk restrictions within the construction work zone. Access for emergency vehicles will be maintained at all times.</p> <p>Driveway Access: The contractor will notify you of any temporary restrictions to your driveway access. Access for emergency vehicles will be maintained at all times.</p>
	<p>Alternate Cycle Routes: During construction the bike lane will be temporarily closed through the work zone. Signs for cyclists will be posted directing them to share the one lane of eastbound and westbound traffic lanes through the work zone. Cyclists should consider Dupont Street or Harbord Street as alternative routes during construction.</p>
