
Road Resurfacing on Dundas Street West from McMurray Avenue to Annette Street and **Reconstruction of McMurray Avenue**

Contract: 19ECS-TI-06MR Expected Start Date: July 2, 2019 Expected End Date: August 25, 2019 *Timeline is subject to change.

The City of Toronto will resurface Dundas Street West from McMurray Avenue to Annette Street. The City will also reconstruct the road, and replace the City-owned portion of substandard water services on McMurray Avenue. This work will commence in July 2019.

This work is part of the Council-approved 2019 Capital Works Program to renew aging city roads and sidewalk for current and future needs.

WHAT TO EXPECT DURING CONSTRUCTION

Construction Impact



Work Hours: Work will take place from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m., Monday to Friday, with work after hours and on weekends as required.

Resurfacing of major intersections at High Park Avenue, Pacific Avenue and Keele Street will take place on a 24 hour basis on select weekends.



Traffic Management: Efforts have been made to manage traffic in the area for the safety of workers, road users and residents. Some of these efforts include adding Local Access signs, revising traffic signal times. Road users should expect delays and increased traffic on nearby main and side streets.

Traffic on Dundas Street West will be reduced to one lane in each direction in the work zone.



TTC Service: This project may affect travel times on the 40 Junction bus and 312 St Clair-Junction bus.

Pedestrians: Sidewalks will be kept open for pedestrian use. When work is taking place on the sidewalk, signage will be placed to provide information about which side of the road to use.
