Road Reconstruction on Linkwood Lane and Road Resurfacing on Spanbridge Road, St. Dennis Drive and Wynford Drive

Contract: 18ECS-TI-05LR
Expected Start Date: Summer 2019
Expected End Date: Winter 2019

The City of Toronto is planning to complete work on a few streets near the Don Valley Parkway and Eglington Avenue East (see Map).

The contract involves road reconstruction work on:


Linkwood Lane from Spanbridge Road to St. Dennis Drive

The contract will also involve road resurfacing on:

- St. Dennis Drive from Linkwood Lane to Wynford Drive
- Spanbridge Road from Linkwood Lane to 45 metres west from Linkwood lane
- Wynford Drive from St. Dennis Drive to 55 metres north of Eglinton Avenue East

Our inspection of these roads show that they need reconstruction or resurfacing and sections of damaged curb and sidewalk need to be replaced to bring them to a state of good repair. This work is part of the Council-approved 2019 Capital Works Program to renew aging city roads and sidewalk for current and future needs.

WHAT TO EXPECT BEFORE CONSTRUCTION

- Work crews will mark sidewalks and curbs requiring replacement and the locations of underground utilities, such as gas, water and cable so that the construction work does not interfere with these utilities.
- Affected properties will receive a Construction Notice approximately two weeks before work begins with more information about the work.



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Accessible Accommodation: Residents who require accommodation (level entry, longer notice, etc.) must contact the **Project Manager** to arrange for access during the construction period.



Important information for owners of sprinkler systems / heated driveways and private landscaping features. Property owners should remove items located within City property limits (boulevard) to avoid damage.

This includes items such as landscaping (plants and pavers), decorative objects, sprinkler systems or heated driveways. If you have a sprinkler system or heated driveway, please contact the **Project Manager** listed below.
