Watermain Replacement on Springhurst Avenue from Spencer Avenue to Fort Rouille Street

Contract: 18ECS-LU-12SU Start Date: February 2019 Original End Date: Late May 2019 NEW End Date (Permanent Restorations): Fall 2019

In March 2019, the City of Toronto started the watermain replacement process on Springhurst Avenue from Spencer Avenue to Fort Rouille Street; the watermain has been successfully replaced. The work was initially supposed to replace the watermain to Dufferin Street. Following conversations with TTC; the City will now combine work to replace the watermain with TTC track from Fort Rouille Street to Dufferin Street as part of future work.

The underground work on Springhurst Avenue will be completed by the end of July 2019, with permanent restoration being completed by Fall 2019. We recognize that a project of this nature is disruptive to the community and appreciate your patience during the inconveniences caused by construction.

WORK DETAILS

To date, the following work has been completed:

- New watermain installed between Spencer Avenue and Fort Rouille Street;
- Replace any City-owned water service pipes that do not meet City standards from the watermain to the private property line commenced; and
- Temporary road restoration.

In the coming weeks the contractor will: The following work remains to be completed:

- Complete water service connections ; and
- Restoring areas affected by construction.
