Start Date: Monday July 22, 2019 at 7 a.m.

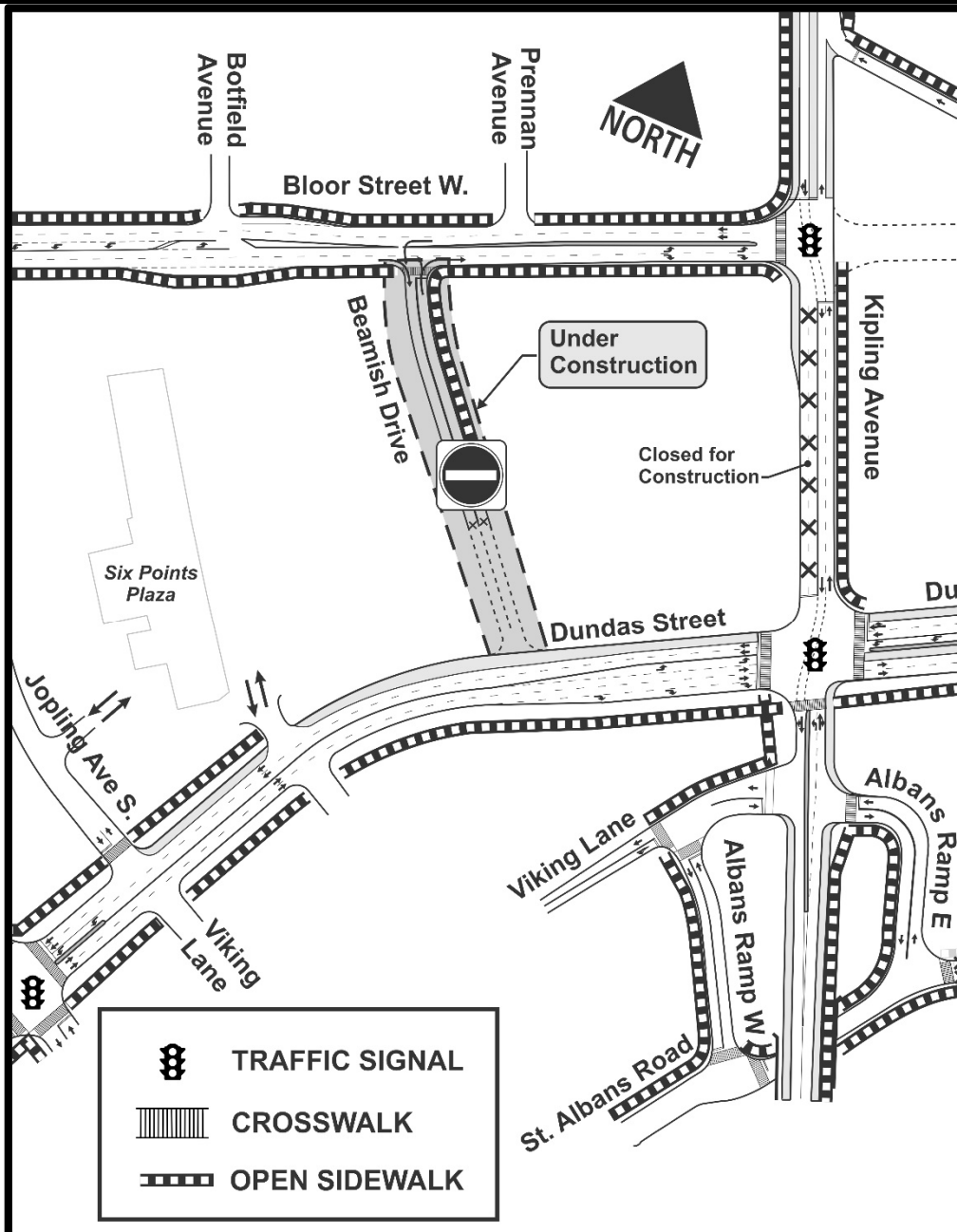
End Date: Friday August 16, 2019 at 7 p.m.

|  | Work Hours: Work will take place from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m., Monday to Friday with work after hours and on weekends as required. |
|  | Accessible Accommodation: Residents who require accommodation (level entry, longer notice, etc.) must contact the Field Ambassador to arrange for access during the construction period. |
|  | Road and Sidewalk Access: In order to complete the work in a safe manner, there will be road restrictions within the construction work zone. Adequate signage will be placed in advance. Access for emergency vehicles will be maintained at all times. |
|  | Traffic Management: Efforts have been made to manage traffic in the area for the safety of workers, road users and residents. |
|  | Garbage & Recycling: Please follow your normal routine. If required, the contractor will move bins to an appropriate location and return them. <i>Please ensure bins are labeled with your address.</i> |
