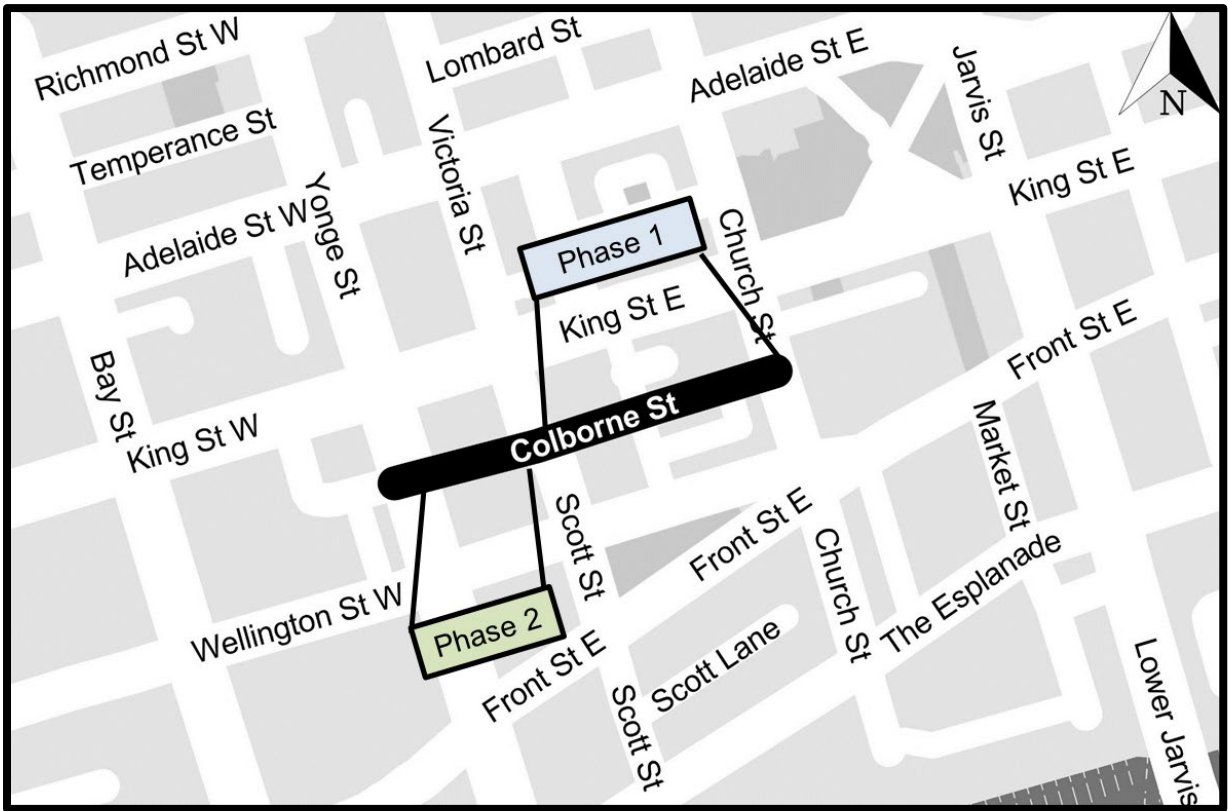
Watermain Replacement on Colborne Street from Church Street to Yonge Street

Contract: 18ECS-LU-12SU
Start Date: January 21, 2019
End Date: September 2019

In January 2019, the City of Toronto started the replacement of the watermain on Phase 1 of Colborne Street from Church Street to Scott Street. Phase 1 of the work has been completed. The contractor will begin Phase 2 of Colborne Street from Scott Street to Yonge Street shortly, with an expected completion in September 2019.

We recognize that a project of this nature is disruptive to the community and apologize for the inconveniences caused by construction.

WORK DETAILS

To date, the following work has been completed on Colborne Street between Church Street and Scott Street:





- Watermain and water service installation; and
- Restoration of affected sidewalks, curbs and roadway.



The following work remains to be completed on Colborne Street between Church Street and Scott Street:

- Installation of a temporary watermain;
- Disinfection and testing of the temporary watermain for water quality;
- Connection of water services to temporary watermain;
- Installation of the new watermain;
- Disinfection and testing of the new watermain for water quality;
- Connection of water services to temporary watermain; and
- Completion of restoration of affected sidewalks, curbs and roadway.

WHAT TO EXPECT DURING CONSTRUCTION

- You may experience dust, noise and other inconveniences. The City will make efforts to reduce the impacts. We appreciate your patience.
- Property owners should remove items located within City property limits (boulevard), such as landscaping and / or decorative objects.
- The City will not be responsible for damage to any privately owned items on City property.

	<p>Work Hours: Work will take place from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m., Monday to Friday, with work after hours and on weekends as required.</p>
	<p>Road and Sidewalk Access: In order to complete the work in a safe manner, there will be road and sidewalk restrictions within the construction work zone. Access for emergency vehicles will be maintained at all times.</p> <p>Driveway Access: The contractor will notify you of any temporary restrictions to your driveway access. If your property has two entrances, one entrance will be kept open at all times.</p>
	<p>Traffic Management: Efforts have been made to manage traffic in the area for the safety of workers, road users and residents. Road users should expect delays and increased traffic on nearby main and side streets.</p> <p>Traffic on Phase 2 of Colborne Street will be reduced to a single lane, controlled by flag personnel. Westbound traffic will only be permitted, with eastbound traffic from Yonge Street closed.</p>
	<p>Parking: Parking in the active work zone is not permitted due to space requirements for construction equipment and materials. If your parked vehicle affects the</p>

	<p>construction work, it will be re-located with no charge to the owner. If your vehicle is moved, please contact parking control for its location at 416-808-2222.</p>
	<p>Garbage & Recycling: Please follow your normal routine. If required, the contractor will move bins to an appropriate location and return them.</p> <p><i>Please ensure that you label your bins with your address.</i></p>
	<p>Restoration: The construction work area will be restored with sod and/or asphalt where required. Interlocking bricks, flagstone on a granular base, or other similar features that are removed from public and private property during construction will be replaced. Lawn seeding and/or laying of sod will be done as needed during ideal growing seasons only - in the spring (April to June) and fall (September to October).</p>
