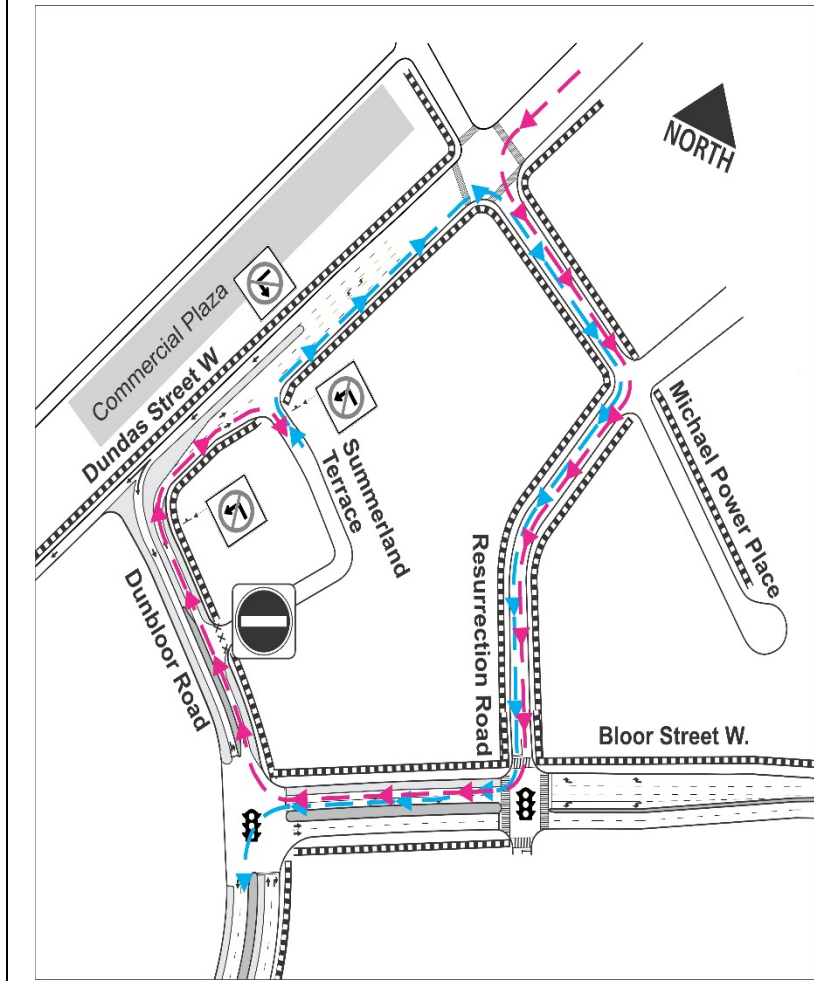
## 3-Day Closure of Summerland Terrace Entrance along Dunbloor Road

The entrance to Summerland Terrace along Dunbloor Road will be closed from **Monday July 8, 2019 at 7 a.m to Wednesday July 10, 2019 at 7 p.m** to complete sidewalk and bike lane work.

**Motorists wishing to ENTER Summerland Terrace**

**Westbound from Dundas Street West, north of Bloor Street West can:**

Travel west on Dundas Street West, south on Michael Power Place, west on Resurrection Road, west on Bloor Street West and north on Dunbloor Road, east on Dundas Street West to Summerland Terrace

**Eastbound from Dundas Street West can:**

Travel north on Dunbloor Road, east on Dundas Street West to Summerland Terrace

**Motorists wishing to EXIT Summerland Terrace**

**Westbound to Dundas Street West can:**

Travel east on Dundas Street West, south on Michael Power Place, west on Resurrection Road, west on Bloor Street West and south on Dundas Street West

**Eastbound to Dundas Street West can:**

Travel east on Dundas Street West

### WHAT TO EXPECT DURING CONSTRUCTION

You may experience dust, noise and other inconveniences. The City will make efforts to reduce the impacts. Your patience is appreciated.

	<b>Road and Sidewalk Access:</b> In order to complete the work in a safe manner, there will be road and sidewalk restrictions within the construction work zone. Adequate signage will be placed in advance. Access for emergency vehicles will be maintained at all times.
	<b>Traffic Management:</b> Efforts have been made to manage traffic in the area for the safety of workers, road users and residents. Road users should expect delays and increased traffic on nearby main and side streets.
