
3-Day Closure of Summerland Terrace Entrance along Dunbloor Road

Westbound from Dundas Street West, north of Bloor Street West can:

Travel west on Dundas Street West, south on Michael Power Place, west on Resurrection Road, west on Bloor Street West and north on Dunbloor Road, east on Dundas Street West to Summerland Terrace

Eastbound from Dundas Street West can: Travel north on Dunbloor Road, east on Dundas Street West to Summerland Terrace

Motorists wishing to <u>EXIT</u> Summerland Terrace

Westbound to Dundas Street West can: Travel east on Dundas Street West, south on Michael Power Place, west on Resurrection Road, west on Bloor Street West and south on Dundas Street West

Eastbound to Dundas Street West can: Travel east on Dundas Street West

WHAT TO EXPECT DURING CONSTRUCTION

You may experience dust, noise and other inconveniences. The City will make efforts to reduce the impacts. Your patience is appreciated.
