Road and Sidewalk Reconstruction on Glen Road from Beaumont Road to Summerhill Avenue and north of Summerhill Avenue

Contract: 18ECS-TI-19LR Start Date: August 12, 2019 Original End Date: October 31, 2019 REVISED End Date: November 30, 2019

*Timeline is subject to change.

In April, the City started road reconstruction on Glen Road. The Contractor encountered delays that resulted in a re-design of the catch basins and road. To date the catch basins have been replaced and, until August 12, the contractor will replace the City-owned portion of substandard water services; this work needs to be completed before the contractor can reconstruct the sidewalk and road.

PROGRESS UPDATE

An additional crew will be on site to speed up the test pit and water service replacement work. To complete this work, the contractor will temporarily close the curb lane to connect the water service to the watermain. The road will re-open once the connection is done.

If your property has a substandard City-owned water service, you will be contacted to coordinate the replacement work. If you are unsure whether your City-owned water service is substandard, please contact the Project Manager to confirm if it needs to be replaced. The City will provide temporary water filters when a substandard water service is replaced.



TTC Service: This project may affect travel times on the 82 Rosedale bus; visit www.ttc.ca for accurate schedule information. Some bus stop locations may be temporarily re-located along Glen Road during construction.

From August 12 to November 30 the contractor will:

- Remove old sidewalks and construct new sidewalks
- Excavate the existing road and concrete base and install a new concrete base and asphalt
- Install pavement line markings and restore areas affected by construction

MAPS, WORK AND TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT PHASES



Phase 1 Beaumount Road to Whitney Avenue August 12 to September 13

- Westbound traffic on Beaumont Road will be able to make left and right turns onto Glen Road.
- Eastbound traffic on Highland Avenue will be able to make left and right turns onto Glen Road.
- Traffic from Bin-Scarth Road, Edgar Avenue and Whitney Avenue will only be able to make northbound turns onto Glen Road.
- East /west travel will be permitted across Glen Road.
- During construction work at the Beaumont Road and Glen Road intersection, a temporary traffic signal will be in place to allow for northbound and southbound traffic movement along Glen Road
