TORONTO LICENSING TRIBUNAL: July 25, 2019

Summary of Decisions

E. Montigny / A. Bakshi / D. Simon

1. **Sibtain Akhtar** (Report No. 7240)
Applicant for a Vehicle-For-Hire Driver's Licence (Application No. B913849)

DECISION:

The Tribunal approved the joint Proposed Resolution, originally signed on July 2, 2019.

Vehicle-For-Hire Driver's Licence will be issued, subject to the following conditions;

- (1) All fees, documents and/or any outstanding requirements must be submitted to the satisfaction of Municipal Licensing and Standards within 30 days of the Tribunal hearing, failing which the application may be cancelled;
- (2) Immediately upon being issued, the license will be suspended for a period of ten (10) days.
- (3) Immediately upon being issued, Vehicle-For-Hire Driver's Licence will be placed on probation for a period of three (3) years to commence on July 25, 2019. Mr. Akhtar is advised that during the probationary period, MLS may make additional checks of any driving, criminal, and by-law charges and convictions against Mr. Akhtar and conduct other investigations, as appropriate, to assess Mr. Akhtar compliance with the requirements of Chapter 546 of the Municipal Code and other applicable laws;
- (4) Mr. Akhtar must provide to Municipal Licensing and Standards every six months, at his own expense, an updated Ministry of Transportation driver's abstract, to be submitted within three days of the following dates:
 - January 24, 2020
 - July 24, 2020
 - January 25, 2021
 - July 26, 2021
 - January 24, 2022
 - July 25, 2022

(5) During the probationary period, if Municipal Licensing and Standards has concerns with any new charges or convictions against Mr. Akhtar or any other concerns with respect to the conduct of the licensee, those matters and report no. 7240 and any updating material, may be brought back before the Tribunal for a full hearing.

- 2. Hamza Mahmood** (Report No. 7182)
Applicant for a Vehicle-For-Hire Driver's Licence (Application No. B892608)

DECISION:

Report No. 7182 was withdrawn by Municipal Licensing and Standards. Application B892608 was cancelled at the request of the applicant.

5. Ahmed Hassan Gedy (Report No. 7114)
Applicant for a Vehicle-For-Hire Driver's Licence (Application No. B868569)

DECISION:

The Tribunal approved the joint Proposed Resolution, originally signed on July 16, 2019.

Vehicle-For-Hire Driver's Licence will be issued, subject to the following conditions;

- (1) All fees, documents and/or any outstanding requirements must be submitted to the satisfaction of Municipal Licensing and Standards within 30 days of the Tribunal hearing, failing which the application may be cancelled;
- (2) Immediately upon being issued, Vehicle-For-Hire Driver's Licence will be placed on probation for a period of three (3) years. Mr. Gedy is advised that during the probationary period, MLS may make additional checks of any driving, criminal, and by-law charges and convictions against Mr. Gedy and conduct other investigations, as appropriate, to assess Mr. Gedy's compliance with the requirements of Chapter 546 of the Municipal Code and other applicable laws;

DECISION:

The Tribunal approved the joint Proposed Resolution, originally signed on July 16, 2019.

Vehicle-For-Hire Driver's Licence will be issued, subject to the following conditions;

- (1) All fees, documents and/or any outstanding requirements must be

submitted to the satisfaction of Municipal Licensing and Standards within 30 days of the Tribunal hearing, failing which the application may be cancelled;

- (2) Immediately upon being issued, Vehicle-For-Hire Driver's Licence will be placed on probation for a period of one (1) years. Mr. Azeez is advised that during the probationary period, MLS may make additional checks of any driving, criminal, and by-law charges and convictions against Mr. Azeez and conduct other investigations, as appropriate, to assess Mr. Azeez's compliance with the requirements of Chapter 546 of the Municipal Code and other applicable laws;
- (3) During the probationary period, if Municipal Licensing and Standards has concerns with any new charges or convictions against Mr. Azeez or any other concerns with respect to the conduct of the licensee, those matters and Report No. 7253 and any updating material, may be brought back before the Tribunal for a full hearing.

DECISION:

The Tribunal approved the joint Proposed Resolution, originally signed on July 16, 2019.

Tow Truck Driver's Licence will be subject to the following conditions;

- (1) All fees, documents and/or any outstanding requirements must be submitted to the satisfaction of Municipal Licensing and Standards within 30 days of the Tribunal hearing, failing which the licence may be cancelled;
- (2) Tow Truck Driver's Licence will be placed on probation for a period of two (2) years. Mr. Waizi is advised that during the probationary period, MLS may make additional checks of any driving, criminal, and by-law charges and convictions against Mr. Waizi and conduct other

investigations, as appropriate, to assess Mr. Waizi's compliance with the requirements of Chapter 545 of the Municipal Code and other applicable laws;

- (3) Prior to each of the next two (2) renewals of the licence, Mr. Waizi must provide to Municipal Licensing and Standards, at his own expense, an original up-to-date abstract of his Criminal Record and Judicial Matters Check;
- (4) During the probationary period, if Municipal Licensing and Standards has concerns with any new charges or convictions against Mr. Waizi or any other concerns with respect to the conduct of the licensee, those matters and Report No. 7202 and any updating material, may be brought back before the Tribunal for a full hearing.

9. Fosten Inc. (Report No. 7249)

DECISION:

The Tribunal approved the joint Proposed Resolution, originally signed on July 16, 2019.

Non-Motorized Refreshment Vehicle Owner's Licence will be issued, subject to the following conditions;

- (1) All fees, documents and/or any outstanding requirements must be submitted to the satisfaction of Municipal Licensing and Standards within 30 days of the Tribunal hearing, failing which the application may be cancelled;
- (2) Immediately upon being issued, Non-Motorized Refreshment Vehicle Owner's Licence will be placed on probation for a period of two (2) years. Mr. Bati is advised that during the probationary period, MLS may make additional checks of any criminal and by-law charges and convictions against Fosten Inc. and Mr. Bati and conduct other investigations, as appropriate, to assess Fosten Inc. and Mr. Bati's compliance with the requirements of Chapter 545 of the Municipal Code and other applicable laws;
- (3) Prior to each of the next two (2) renewals of the licence, Mr. Bati must provide to Municipal Licensing and Standards, at his own expense, an original up-to-date abstract of his Criminal Record and Judicial Matters Check;
- (4) During the probationary period, if Municipal Licensing and Standards

has concerns with any new charges or convictions against Fosten Inc. or Mr. Bati or any other concerns with respect to the conduct of the licensee, those matters and Report No. 7249 and any updating material, may be brought back before the Tribunal for a full hearing.

10. Hasina Akhtar (Report No. 7244)

Applicant for a Driving School Instructor with Vehicle Licence
(Application No. B925608)

DECISION:

The Tribunal approved the joint Proposed Resolution, originally signed on July 16, 2019.

Driving School Instructor with Vehicle Licence will be issued, subject to the following conditions;

- (1) All fees, documents and/or any outstanding requirements must be submitted to the satisfaction of Municipal Licensing and Standards within 30 days of the Tribunal hearing, failing which the application may be cancelled;
- (2) Immediately upon being issued, Driving School Instructor with Vehicle Licence will be placed on probation for a period of two (2) years. Ms Akhtar is advised that during the probationary period, MLS may make additional checks of any driving, criminal, and by-law charges and convictions against Ms Akhtar and conduct other investigations, as appropriate, to assess Ms Akhtar's compliance with the requirements of Chapter 545 of the Municipal Code and other applicable laws;
- (3) During the probationary period, if Municipal Licensing and Standards has concerns with any new charges or convictions against Ms Akhtar or any other concerns with respect to the conduct of the licensee, those matters and Report No. 7244 and any updating material, may be brought back before the Tribunal for a full hearing.
