## Watermain Replacement & Road Reconstruction on Burnhamill Place from Old Burnhamthorpe Road to Mill Road

**Start Date: June 3, 2019**

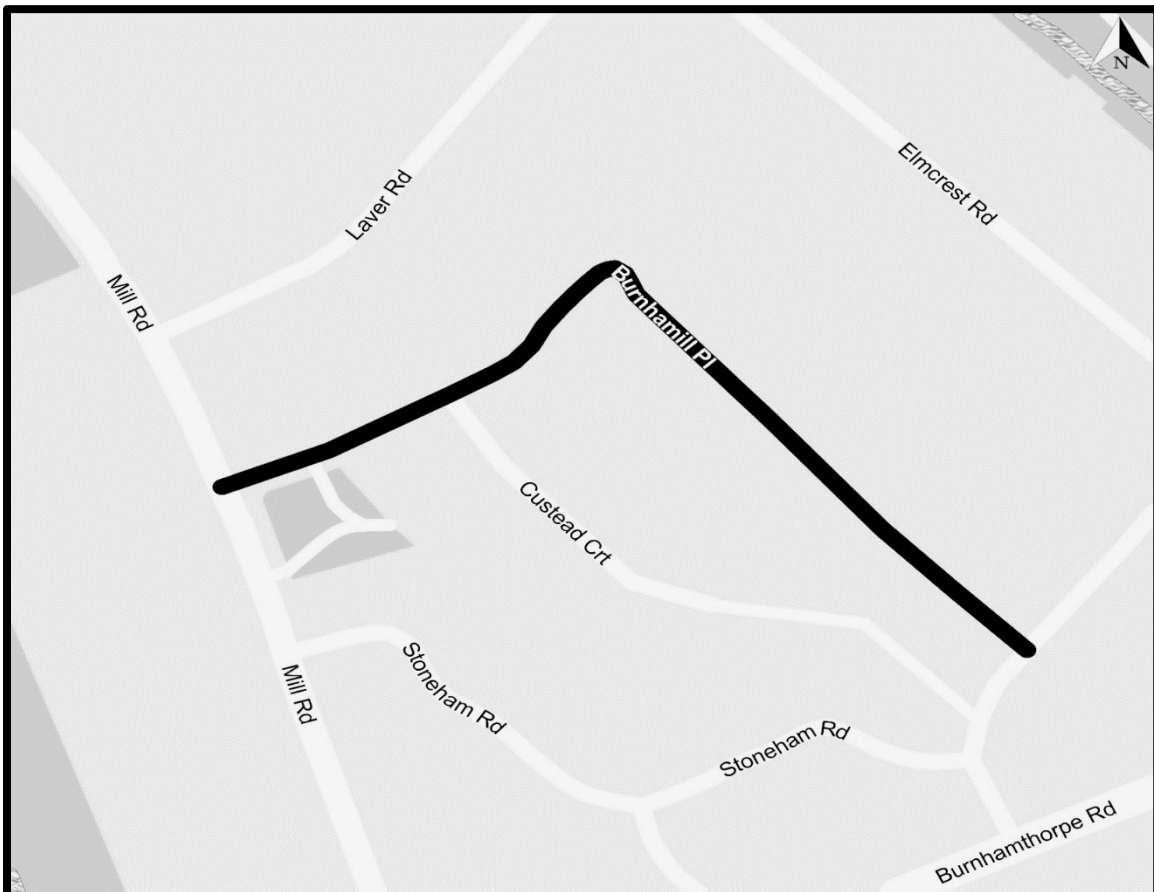
**End Date: October 31, 2019**

The City of Toronto has nearly completed the watermain and substandard water service replacement on Burnhamill Place from Old Burnhamthorpe Road to Mill Road. The Contractor will now reconstruct the road and sidewalks within the project limits.

The remaining work will be delivered in several phases that will affect driveway and parking access. Please abide by signage and the recommended actions in the following pages.

<b>Work Type and Location</b>	<b>SCHEDULE*</b> <i>Timeline is subject to change</i>	<b>ACCESS RESTRICTIONS</b>
<b>Burnhamill Place Roadway reconstruction</b>	Ongoing	-The Contractor will remove and replace the road's pavement. -Driveways will be accessible after hours, but residents are requested not to park curbside during work hours from 7 a.m. to 9 p.m., Monday to Friday, and 9 a.m. to 7 p.m., Saturday.
<b>Burnhamill Place Sidewalk replacement</b>  -The contractor will remove and replace the sidewalk of the street	July 22 to July 26	-Residents will not have access to their driveways on Burnhamill Place. Residents are requested not to park curbside during work hours from 7 a.m. to 9 p.m., Monday to Friday, and 9 a.m. to 7 p.m., Saturday.
<b>Burnhamill Place Curb replacement</b>  -The contractor will remove and replace the curb of the street	July 29 to August 2	-Residents will not have access to their driveways on Burnhamill Place. Residents are requested not to park curbside during work hours from 7 a.m. to 9 p.m., Monday to Friday, and 9 a.m. to 7 p.m., Saturday.
<b>Burnhamill Place Boulevard restoration</b>	Following curb and sidewalk replacement, and roadway reconstruction.	-Individual driveway access will be obstructed for driveway replacement -Residents will be provided advance notice from the contractor for <u>individual</u> driveway obstructions.
<b>Burnhamill Place Road repaving</b>  -the contractor will grind old asphalt and lay a new asphalt surface	Following boulevard restoration.	-Driveway access will be momentarily (20 minutes) interrupted as asphalt removal and repaving equipment progress along the street.

## WHAT TO EXPECT DURING CONSTRUCTION

- You may experience dust, noise and other inconveniences. The City will make efforts to reduce the impacts. We appreciate your patience.
- The City will not be responsible for damage to any privately owned items on City property.

	<p><b>Extended Work Hours:</b> Work will take place from 7 a.m. to 9 p.m., Monday to Friday, and 9 a.m. to 7 p.m., Saturday. The Contractor on this project may use extended work hours to minimize traffic disruption and to shorten the project duration.</p>
	<p><b>Road and Sidewalk Access:</b> In order to complete the work in a safe manner, there will be road and sidewalk restrictions within the construction work zone. Access for emergency vehicles will be maintained at all times.</p> <p><b>Driveway Access:</b> The contractor will notify you of any temporary restrictions to your driveway access. If your property has two entrances, one entrance will be kept open at all times. Vehicles must be removed from driveways before 7 a.m.</p> <p><b><i>To help the contractor to do the work uninterrupted, we advise you to move your vehicle from your driveway to a nearby side street before 7 a.m.</i></b></p>
	<p><b>Parking:</b> Parking in the active work zone is not permitted due to space requirements for construction equipment and materials. If your parked vehicle affects the construction work, it will be re-located with no charge to the owner. If your vehicle is moved, please contact parking control for its location at <b>416-808-2222</b>.</p> <p>Residents are encouraged to utilize on-street parking on adjacent streets during work hours and overnight driveway access closures.</p> <p>In the event you receive a traffic ticket for on-street parking during this period of construction, you may choose to dispute your ticket following the process listed on the reverse side of the parking infraction notice. <b><i>You may use this notice as part of your defence for parking consideration during construction; however, the Field Ambassador does not have the authority to cancel any parking tickets.</i></b></p>
	<p><b>Accessible Accommodation:</b> Residents who require accommodation (level entry, longer notice, etc.) must contact the <b>Field Ambassador</b> to arrange for access during the construction period.</p>
	<p><b>Caution:</b> Until the road is repaved, there will be a short period of time where the road will be lower than final grade. This will result in height differences up to 50mm at driveway entrances, sewer manhole covers, and watermain valve covers. Residents are advised to adjust driving speeds appropriately and exercise caution in these areas.</p>

	<p><b>Garbage &amp; Recycling:</b> Please follow your normal routine. If required, the contractor will move bins to an appropriate location and return them. <b><i>Please ensure that you label your bins with your address.</i></b></p>
	<p><b>Restoration:</b> The construction work area will be restored with sod and/or asphalt where required. Interlocking bricks, flagstone on a granular base, or other similar features that are removed from public property during construction will be replaced. Lawn seeding and/or laying of sod will be done as needed during ideal growing seasons only - in the spring (April to June) and fall (September to October). Areas affected by the construction work (curb, sidewalk, driveway and grassy areas) will be restored.</p>
	<p><b>Important information for owners of sprinkler systems/heated driveways and private landscaping features.</b> Property owners should remove items located within City property limits (boulevard) to avoid damage.</p> <p>This includes items such as landscaping (plants and pavers), decorative objects, sprinkler systems or heated driveways. For details on removal of such items, please contact the <b>Field Ambassador</b> listed below.</p>
