

Albion Road Culvert Replacement over Albion Creek

Contract: 19ECS-TI-12BE
Expected Start Date: July 2, 2019
Expected End Date: November 2019
*Timeline is subject to change. Future notice to be provided.

The City of Toronto will replace the steel pipe arch culvert at Albion Road over Albion Creek starting in the summer of 2019. This work will ensure that the culvert meets today's standards and remains safe for vehicles and pedestrians into the future. The project is part of the Council-approved 2019 Capital Works Program.

The City's contractor will:

- Replace existing culvert, gabion basket walls, steel beam guide rails
- Replace the curb and sidewalk

Construction will take place in two stages:

Stage/Dates	Traffic Management	Work Hours
Stage 1 (north half) July 2019 to August 2019	Traffic on Albion Road between Benstrow Avenue and Islington Avenue will be reduced to a single lane in each direction during all stages of the work	Monday to Friday, 7 a.m. to 11 p.m., with work after
Stage 2 (south half) September 2019 – November 2019	 Access to Todd Brook Drive from Albion Road (and vice versa) will be closed. Signage will be erected in advance of the work to inform road users of this closure. 	hours and on weekends as required.

WHAT TO EXPECT DURING CONSTRUCTION		
1	Work Hours : Monday to Friday: 7 a.m. to 11 p.m., with work after hours and on weekends as required.	
٤	Sidewalk Access: Sidewalk access along Albion Road will be maintained at all times during the project. A covered walkway/hoarding will be erected to protect pedestrians travelling through the work zone.	
#	Access to Adjacent Properties: Access to driveways along Albion Road in close proximity to the project will be maintained during the work, but may be impacted during concrete sidewalk construction and/or asphalt paving activities. Residents impacted by this will receive additional notice prior to the work.	
	TTC Impacts: Some TTC stops along Albion Road may be impacted during the work. Visit ttc.ca for accurate schedule information.	
d .	Restoration: Areas affected by construction will be restored.
