Road and Sidewalk Reconstruction on Glen Road from Beaumont Road to Summerhill Avenue and north of Summerhill Avenue

Contract: 18ECS-TI-19LR

Start Date: August 12, 2019 Original End Date: October 31, 2019

REVISED Start Date: September 3, 2019 End Date: November 30, 2019

In recent weeks, the City has experienced some challenges with the contractor and their scheduling of the road reconstruction phase of work on Glen Road. The contractor has now committed to starting this work on September 3 with additional crews to expedite the work. Traffic on Glen Road will be reduced to one northbound lane only for the duration of the project. Traffic management phases have been updated, please see below.

The City will continue to manage the situation and provide updates as needed.

PROGRESS UPDATE

The catch basins have been replaced and the water service replacement is 80% complete on Glen Road.

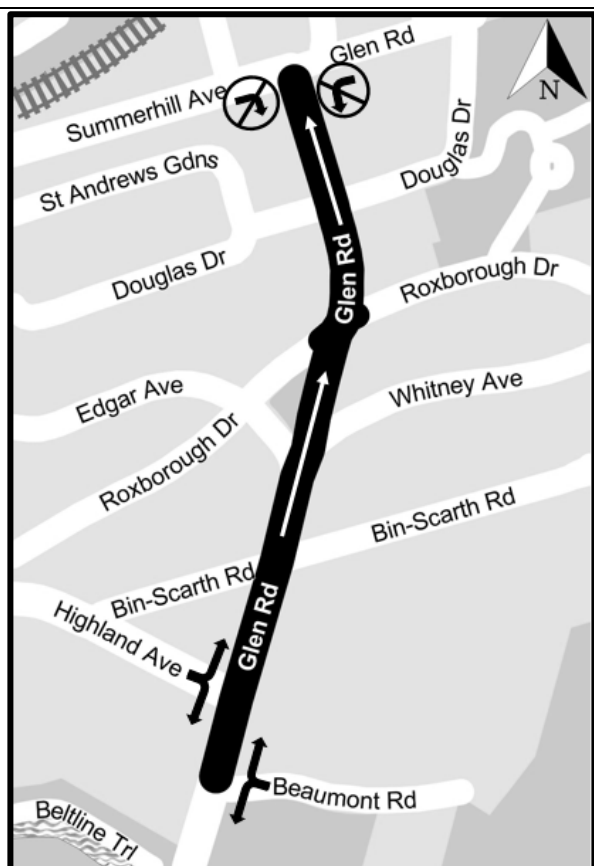

From September 3 to November 30 the contractor will:


- Remove old sidewalks and construct new sidewalks
- Excavate the existing road and concrete base and install a new concrete base and asphalt
- Install pavement line markings and restore areas affected by construction

MAPS, WORK AND TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT PHASES



Phase 1 Beaumont Road to Summerhill Avenue September 3 to October 25

- Westbound traffic on Beaumont Road will be able to make left and right turns onto Glen Road.
- Eastbound traffic on Highland Avenue will be able to make left and right turns onto Glen Road.
- Traffic from Bin-Scar Road, Edgar Avenue, Whitney Avenue, Roxborough Drive, Douglas Drive will only be able to make northbound turns onto Glen Road.
- East /west travel will be permitted across Glen Road at each intersection.
- During construction work at the Beaumont Road and Glen Road intersection, a temporary traffic signal will be in place to allow for northbound and southbound traffic movement along Glen Road from Highland Avenue to the Bridge.
- No right turns from eastbound Summerhill Avenue onto Glen Road.
- Traffic travelling west on Glen Road will not be permitted to make a left turn onto Glen Road.



Phase 2
North of Summerhill Avenue to 337 Glen Road
October 28 to November 29

- Westbound traffic on Douglas Drive will be able to make a right turn onto Glen Road.
- Eastbound traffic on Glen Road will be able to make a left turn onto Glen Road.
- The lane at the north end of Glen Road will be open to one way (northeast) traffic to allow for local traffic to exit the construction area.
