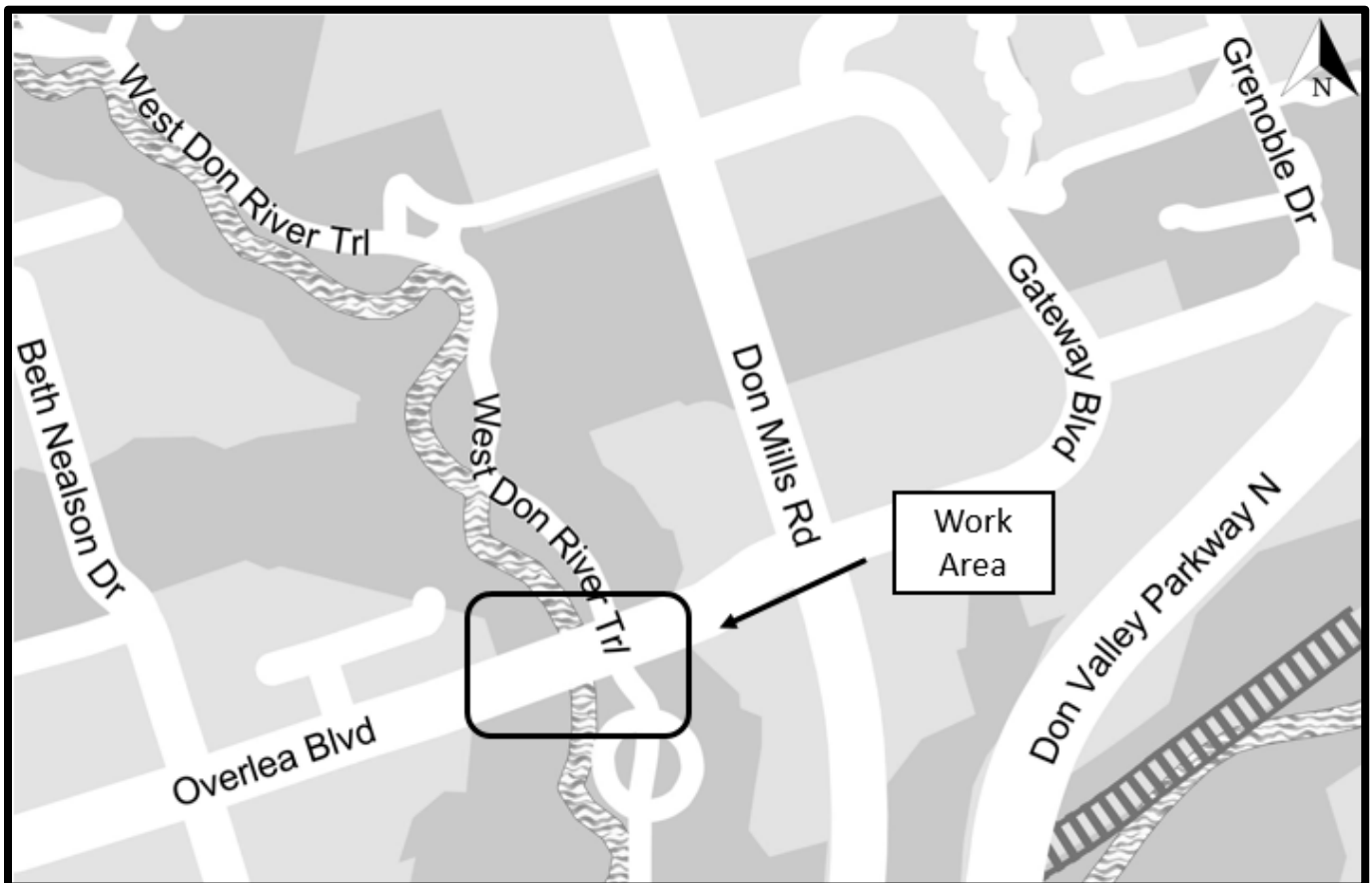
## Overlea Boulevard Bridge Inspection over the Don River

**Contract: [RFP No. 9117-17-5059]**  
**Expected Start Date: August 12, 2019**  
**Expected End Date: August 23, 2019**

The City of Toronto will inspect the Overlea Boulevard Bridge over the Don River. This work will help the City determine the level of work needed for an upcoming rehabilitation and ensure that the bridge meets today's standards and remains safe for vehicles and pedestrians into the future. The project is part of the Council-approved 2022 Capital Works Program.

These inspections will affect lanes of traffic and sidewalk access. Signage will be posted

## WORK DETAILS

Inspection crews will then:

- Complete a bridge decktop condition assessment
- Hammer sound soffit and evaluate the deck condition from underneath
- Carry out the structural steel inspection

## WHAT TO EXPECT DURING CONSTRUCTION

- You may experience noise and traffic delays due to single lane road closure and other inconveniences. The City will make efforts to reduce impacts. We appreciate your patience.

	<p><b>Work Hours:</b> Work will take place from 7 a.m. to 4 p.m. Monday to Friday, with work on weekends as required.</p>
	<p><b>Road and Sidewalk Access:</b> In order to complete the work in a safe manner, there will be road and sidewalk interruptions within the inspection work area.</p> <p>The sidewalk on Overlea Boulevard will remain open during the inspection. A flagger will be present to guide pedestrians at all times.</p>
	<p><b>Traffic Management:</b> Efforts have been made to manage traffic in the area for the safety of workers and road users. Road users should expect delays and increased traffic on nearby main and side streets.</p> <p>In order to complete this work, eastbound and westbound lane closures on Overlea Boulevard at both ends of the bridge will be required; however only one direction will be affected at any given time.</p>
