## Islington Avenue and Redwater Drive Culvert Replacement over Humber River

Contract: 19ECS-TI-12BE

Expected Start Date: June 2019 Expected End Date: November 2020 \*Timeline is subject to change. Future notice to be provided.

The City of Toronto will replace the concrete culvert at Islington Avenue over Humber River and rehabilitate the concrete culvert at Redwater Drive over Humber River. This work will ensure that the culverts meet today's standards and remain safe for vehicles and pedestrians into the future. The project is part of the Council-approved 2019 Capital Works Program.

#### WORK DETAILS

For the concrete culvert at Islington Avenue over Humber River, the City's contractor will:

- Replace existing culvert, wingwalls, steel beam guiderails and fencing
- Replace the curb and sidewalk

#### For the Redwater Drive culvert over the Humber River, the City's contractor will:

- Relocate Hydro poles and repair existing culvert;
- Replace existing concrete wingwalls and fencing
- Replace the curb and sidewalk

#### Construction on each culvert will take place in two stages:

### WHAT TO EXPECT DURING CONSTRUCTION

÷	<ul> <li>Sidewalk Access: In order to complete the work in a safe manner, there will be sidewalk restrictions within the construction work area.</li> <li>Islington Avenue culvert over Humber River: Sidewalk access along Islington Avenue will be maintained at all times during the project. A covered walkway/hoarding will be erected to protect pedestrians travelling through the work zone.</li> </ul>
	<b>Redwater Drive culvert over Humber River:</b> A minimum of one sidewalk will be maintained at all times. Access from Toledo Road to the trails along the watercourse may be impacted by the work.
	Access to Adjacent Properties: Access to driveways in close proximity to the project sites will be maintained during the work, but may be impacted during concrete sidewalk construction and/or asphalt paving activities. Alternate parking arrangements will be made for residents impacted by this work.
	<b>Islington Avenue culvert over Humber River:</b> Left turns to and from driveways on Islington Avenue will be restricted due to the traffic control under use for the project.
	<b>TTC Service:</b> Some TTC stops along Islington Avenue may be impacted during the work and some routes may experience slower travel times. Visit <u>ttc.ca</u> for accurate schedule information.
	<b>Restoration:</b> Areas affected by construction will be restored.
