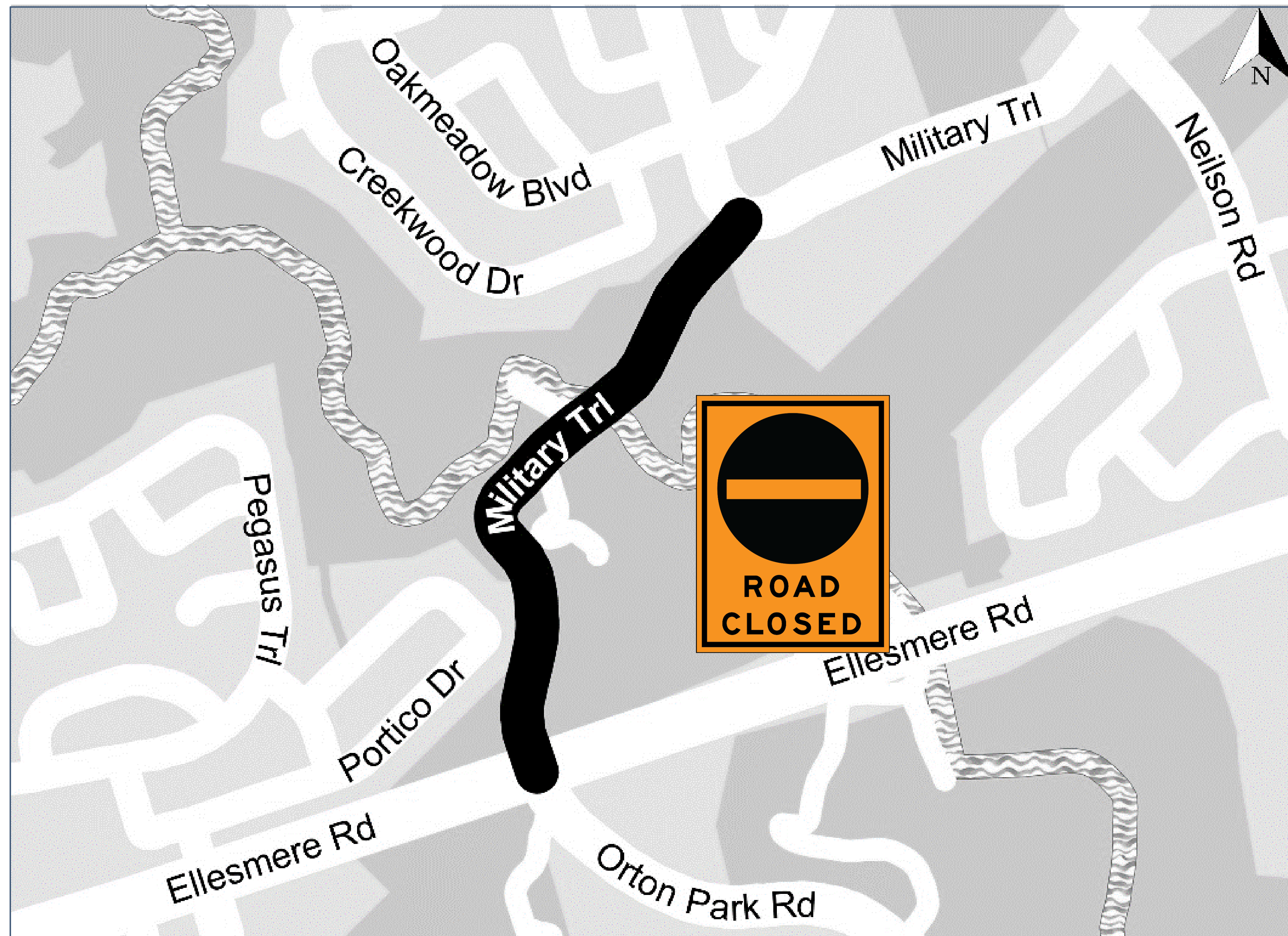


# Military Trail Road Reconstruction

## from Ellesmere Road to Highcastle Road



**Expected Start Date: March 2020**  
**Expected End Date: November 2020**

### Road Closed

- This project will take approximately eight months to complete.
- Military Trail from Ellesmere Rd. to Highcastle Rd. will be closed to vehicles, pedestrians and cyclists.

This timeline estimation includes the following:

- complete removal of the existing road and road base
- installation of new road and road base
- installation of tie-backs and retaining walls
- installation of new sidewalk, curb, guardrail and handrail
- line painting



# What are we doing?

## Background

### 2017

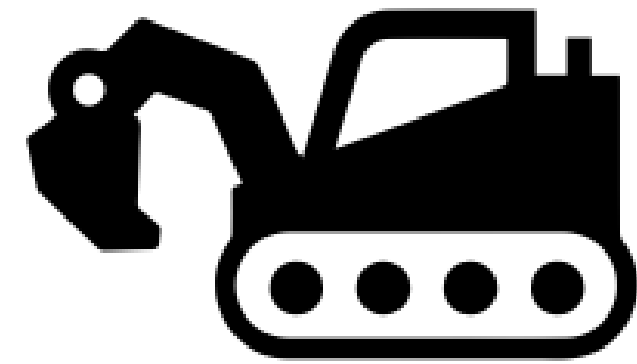
- A watermain break caused damage to the road.
- Temporary road repairs were completed and Military Trail was re-opened.

### 2018

- Started detailed design for road reconstruction and sidewalk construction.
- The City hired a consultant for the project design.

### 2019

- TRCA and Toronto Urban Forestry are reviewing the design.



## Reconstruction

Road reconstruction involves removing and replacing the existing road base material. It is replaced to current City standards and specifications.



## Sidewalk

A new sidewalk will be constructed on the west side of Military Trail. Retaining walls will be used to hold existing slopes/soil in place next to the new sidewalk.



## Relocation

The road will be realigned slightly to the east to accommodate the construction of a new sidewalk on the west side of the road.



## Safety

Road Safety Features include a reduction of the posted speed limit from 50km/hr to 30km/hr, warning signs will be posted and guardrails and handrails will be installed along the new sidewalk.
