## Laneway Reconstruction on five Laneways South of Lakeshore Boulevard West between Second Street and Ninth Street and Laneway west of Fifth Street and South of Birmingham Street

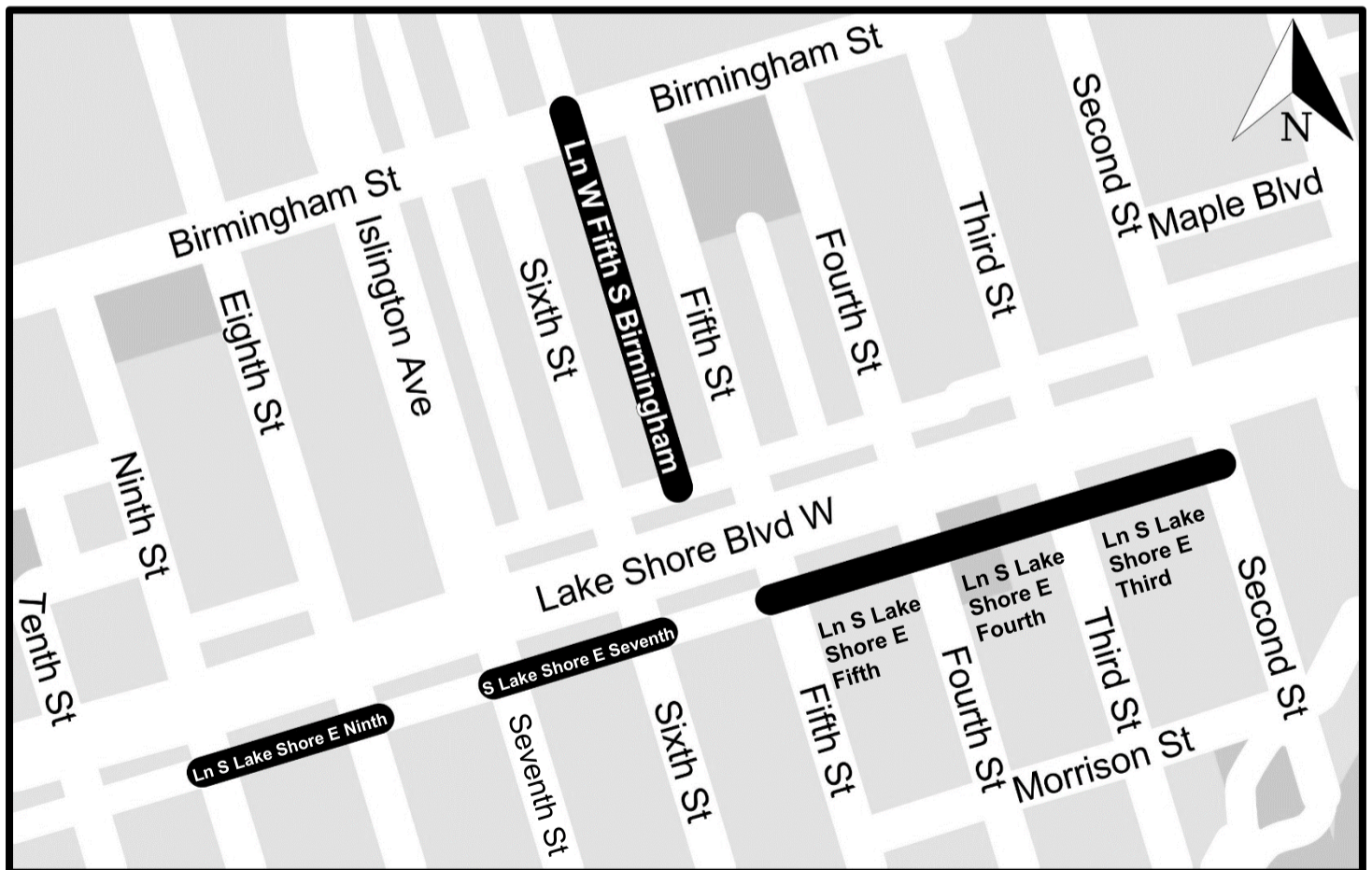
The City of Toronto is planning to reconstruct the laneway west of Fifth Street and south of Birmingham Street and five laneways south of Lake Shore Boulevard (see map):

- East of Ninth Street
- East of Seventh Street
- East of Fifth Street
- East of Fourth Street
- East of Third Street

Our inspection of the laneways shows that they need reconstruction to bring them to a state of good repair.

This project is part of the Council-approved 2019 Capital Works Program to renew aging city roads and sidewalk for current and future needs.

### WHAT TO EXPECT BEFORE CONSTRUCTION

- Work crews will mark sidewalks and curbs requiring replacement and the locations of underground utilities, such as gas, water and cable so that the construction work does not interfere with these utilities.

- Affected properties will receive a Construction Notice approximately two weeks before work begins with more information about the work.
- The City will not be responsible for damage to any privately owned items on City property.

	<p><b>Accessible Accommodation:</b> Residents who require accommodation (level entry, longer notice, etc.) must contact the <b>Field Ambassador</b> to arrange for access during the construction period.</p>
	<p><b>Access to Your Home:</b> The City-hired contractor may need access to your home to complete a pre-construction survey. Affected properties will receive a pre-construction survey request to schedule a time to complete the survey.</p>
	<p><b>Important information for owners of sprinkler systems / heated driveways and private landscaping features.</b> Property owners should remove items located within City property limits (boulevard) to avoid damage.</p> <p>This includes items such as landscaping (plants and pavers), decorative objects, sprinkler systems or heated driveways. If you have a sprinkler system or heated driveway, please contact the <b>Field Ambassador</b> listed below.</p>
