

To support and promote the economic vitality of Danforth Avenue

The Economic and Retail Study (6km from Broadview to Victoria Park) will:

- Identify key demographic and economic trends on the Danforth to aid in developing growth strategies.
- Identify the push-pull factors that attract or deter businesses to/from the neighbourhood.
- Research who lives and works in the neighbourhood (potential shoppers).
- Understand what stores and services are available (existing supply).
- Identify where people are going to and where they're coming from (origin and destination survey).
