- Copy of Certificate of Insurance (comprehensive general liability, minimum \$5,000,000.00, City of Toronto and Toronto Fire Services as Co. Insured)
- Written authorization from registered property owner
- Pyro plan if open flame are being employed as per <u>NFPA 160</u> (http://www.nfpa.org/codes-and-standards/document-information-pages?mode=code&code=160)
- Location of effects storage and method of disposal
- An assessment of the likelihood of harm to people and property resulting in the use of the special effect pyrotechnic
- Applicable fee of \$577.81, payable to the Treasurer, City of Toronto
