Types of extinguishers are to be indicated. If the site of the burn/flame effects is other than the Applicant's address, written authorization from registered property owner is to be submitted.

Toronto Fire Services **Communications Division** is to be notified at **416-338-9000** prior to commencing burn/flame effect performance and immediately after burn/flame effect performance to prevent unnecessary Toronto Fire Services responses.

This Permit shall be onsite during the hours of the burn/flame effect performance. Failure to provide proof of permit could result in fines or charges.



Permit Application Outdoor Open Air Burning Outdoor Flame Effects

Participants shall be kept a safe distances from the fire. The onsite supervisor shall have a readily accessible means of calling 911 for assistance during the hours of the burn/flame effect performance. A fire extinguisher/charged water hose shall be readily available during the hours of the burn/flame effect performance. Smoke to be kept to a minimum and wind conditions are to be taken into account. The fire shall be completely extinguished before leaving the site. A Pyro Plan if Open Flame is being employed in front of an audience as per NFPA 160.

Note: If a fire ban has been issued during the times indicated in the Burning/Flame Effect Details section on page 1, this Permit becomes invalid. Please check the website for information.
