

F.G. Gardiner Expressway Strategic Rehabilitation Cherry Street to Lower Jarvis Street Overnight Noise Levels

The City to committed to providing timely updates and communications to the residents within the vicinity of the Gardiner Expressway Rehabilitation construction work. This notice provides a list of upcoming construction activities, work details and anticipated noise levels.

The next phase of construction work will take place on the westbound off-ramp to Jarvis/Sherbourne Street and Gardiner Expressway between Cherry and Parliament Streets. In order to complete the project on time and work is scheduled to occur around-the-clock.

The following construction activities are scheduled for the westbound off-ramp to Jarvis/Sherbourne Streets and the north half of the Gardiner Expressway (Cherry to Parliament Streets). UNDERSTANDING NOISE LEVELS ON THIS PROJECT

To help understand the impact of noise, the noise scale below relates the expected construction noise to other comparable noise levels. Please note the actual level of noise associated with each construction activity may vary from the noise scale below depending on the type of construction work taking place and a person's proximity to where the construction activity is occurring.
