These emails will also invite you to schedule an appointment for your next testing stage. Candidates who are offered conditional employment following Stage 4 will be required to successfully complete a 2-day orientation and evaluation (or equivalency) with the Sunnybrook Centre for Prehospital Medicine. Additional administrative dates will occur during this time.

Conditional employment offers are expected to occur as early as the week of February 17<sup>th</sup>, 2020. Toronto Paramedic Services anticipates having multiple onboarding sessions from March until June 2020.
